November 30, 2024 – CALGARY FLAMES [2] vs. PITTSBURGH PENGUINS [6]

The Calgary Flames wrapped up a four-game road trip on Saturday night in Pittsburgh. Pittsburgh would score the only goal of the first with Anthony Beauvillier giving the Penguins a 1-0 edge. The home side would extend their lead in the middle stanza with a pair of goals to hold a 3-0 advantage heading into the third. In the final frame, Calgary would get goals from Jonathan Huberdeau and Nazem Kadri, but Pittsburgh would add three more to knock off the Flames 6-2.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the second of two meetings this season between the Flames and Blue Jackets. Calgary fell 5-2 in these clubs' first meeting last Friday.

This is a Pacific Division versus Metropolitan Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 5-3-0 against Metropolitan Division teams and a record of 6-4-3 against Eastern Conference opponents.

GAUDREAU'S LEGACY:

Tonight's contest will mark the first meeting at the Scotiabank Saddledome between Calgary and Columbus since the passing of Johnny Gaudreau. An impactful player for both franchises, Gaudreau led either the Blue Jackets or Flames in points for eight of nine seasons from 2015-16 to 2023-24: CGY (2015-16 to 2018-19 & 2020-21 to 2021-22); CBJ (2022-23 to 2023-24). Gaudreau posted 609 points from 210 goals and 399 assists in 602 games in a Calgary Flames sweater and represented the Flames at six different NHL All-Star games. Gaudreau also won the Lady Byng Trophy in 2017 and was named to the NHL First All-Star Team in 2021-22 during his Flames tenure.

THIRD PERIOD SCORING:

Entering tonight's game, the Flames have scored 33 third period goals so far this season, the fifth-most in the NHL in 2024-25. Only the Los Angeles Kings, Vegas Golden Knights, Winnipeg Jets, and New Jersey Devils have recorded more final frame markers, and Calgary is tied with the league's fourth-best third period goal differential at +8.

DOME SWEET DOME:

Calgary returns to the Scotiabank Saddledome tied with the third-most wins on home ice this season (9). Calgary has recorded 18 points at the 'Dome in 2024-25, and the only teams to record more points at home are the Toronto Maple Leafs and Dallas Stars.

TOTAL RECALL:

On Monday, the Calgary Flames announced the recall of forwards Jakob Pelletier and Walker Duehr from the Calgary Wranglers. Additionally, the Flames announced Justin Kirkland has been placed on IR, and Adam Klapka has been reassigned to the American Hockey League.

Pelletier has skated in 20 AHL contests so far this season, scoring three goals and 16 helpers for 19 points, with his 16 assists ranking fourth in the American Hockey League at the time of his recall. The 23-year-old has played 37 games in the NHL with four goals and six assists for 10 points and was the Flames first-round pick (26th overall) in the 2019 NHL Draft.

Walker Duehr has also skated in 20 AHL outings this season and currently has the second-most goals on the Wranglers with 11. The Sioux Falls, SD native has also recorded eight assists for 19 points and scored in his most recent outing in Manitoba on November 29th. Duehr was an undrafted free agent signing by the Flames on April 11, 2021, and has 68 games of NHL experience with nine goals and nine assists.

JUNIOR CONNECTIONS:

Flames blueliner Rasmus Andersson and Blue Jackets forward Kevin Labanc were teammates on the Barrie Colts of the OHL for the 2014-15 and 2015-16 campaign. Flames winger Blake Coleman and Blue Jackets centre Sean Kuraly played together on the USHL's Indiana Ice for two seasons from 2009 to 2011. The pair would also find themselves playing together again at Miami University (Ohio) for an additional three seasons from 2012-13 to 2014-15. A more recent connection includes Calgary's Matt Coronato and Columbus's Adam Fantilli who were USHL Champions with the Chicago Steel in 2020-21. Coronato was named the USHL's Forward of the Year after leading the league with 48 goals in 51 games.



HANLEY MAN:

Flames blueliner Joel Hanley skated in his 199th NHL game in Columbus on Nov. 29 and is just one game away from 200 in his NHL career. Hanley can become the 17th-active undrafted defenceman to reach 200 games in their NHL career. The Keswick, ON native made his NHL debut on March 20th, 2016 against Calgary as a member of the Montreal Canadiens, and has spent time with Montreal, Arizona, Dallas, and Calgary through his 199-previous NHL games.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Nazem Kadri (1-1—2) and Jonathan Huberdeau (1-1—2) scored and assisted on each other's goals to each record multiple points. Since they both joined the Flames in 2022-23, the duo rank first and second in multi-point games for the club (Kadri: 33 & Huberdeau: 26).
