FLAMES LAST GAME RECAP

November 9, 2024 - CALGARY FLAMES [2] vs. BUFFALO SABRES [3] (SO)

Game Summary I Event Summary

The Calgary Flames finished off a three-game eastern road swing on Saturday afternoon in Buffalo. The Sabres would open the scoring 1:11 into the contest with Zach Benson giving Buffalo an early advantage. The home side would double their lead midway through the frame to lead 2-0 through 20. In the second, Matt Coronato would get the Flames on the board and cut the deficit to one heading into the final frame. Calgary would outshoot Buffalo 12-4 in the third, and Mikael Backlund would draw the Flames even late in the period to force extra time. Overtime would solve nothing, and the Flames would eventually fall in a shootout.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the first of three meetings this season between the Flames and Kings. Calgary and Los Angeles split their fourgame season-series in 2023-24, with the home side winning on all four occasions.

This is a Pacific Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 2-2-1 against Pacific Division teams and a record of 3-4-1 against Western Conference opponents.

WEEGSY BABY:

MacKenzie Weegar registered an assist on the Flames first goal in Buffalo on Saturday to improve his point totals to 27 goals and 63 helpers for 90 points in 178 games since being acquired by the Flames prior to the 2022-23 season. His 90 points are the second-most by any Flames defenseman through that span behind Rasmus Andersson (24-75—99 in 172 GP).

HUBY DOO:

With his assist on Saturday afternoon, Jonathan Huberdeau recorded his 499th career helper, one shy of reaching 500 NHL assists. Huberdeau is looking to join Nikita Kucherov and Johnny Gaudreau as the third skater from the 2011 NHL draft to reach 500 NHL assists and become the 25th active skater in the NHL to reach the milestone.

THIRD PERIOD SCORING:

With another goal in the third period on Saturday, Calgary has now upped their third-period goal total to 22 on the 2024-25 campaign. Only the Los Angeles Kings, the Winnipeg Jets, the Vegas Golden Knights and New Jersey Devils have scored more times in the final frame of a game this season.

LOOK BACKS AT IT:

With his goal on Saturday afternoon in Buffalo, Mikael Backlund scored his 102nd road-goal in his career to tie Lanny McDonald for the fifth-most road goals in Flames franchise history. The only players to score more are: Jarome Iginla (257), Theoren Fleury (159), Joe Nieuwendyk (133), and Gary Roberts (109).

FAMILY TIES:

Kings forward Samuel Helenius's father Sami Helenius was part of the Flames organization for five seasons from 1994-95 until 1998-99. Sami played in 272 games for the Flames AHL affiliate the Saint John Flames and skated in his first seven NHL games in a Calgary Flames sweater.

A SHOOTING ZAR:

Following his goal on Tuesday in Montreal, the Flames have won seven-straight games in which Connor Zary scores a goal, a streak which began on February 6th, 2024. Calgary is also 10-1-0 in the last 11 games in which Zary has found the back of the net.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Jonathan Huberdeau scored his 200th NHL goal against the LA Kings last season on November 14th, 2022.

In these teams' first meeting last season, Blake Coleman became the first Flames player to score a shorthanded goal and power-play goal in the same game since Noah Hanifin on November 25th, 2018 in Arizona.

Four of Nazem Kadri's five goals this season have come in the third period.

Kings goaltender David Rittich spent five seasons with the Flames organization from 2016-17 to 2021-22, appearing in 130 games in the Flames crease. Kings forward Trevor Lewis spent the 2021-22 and 2022-23 campaigns in Calgary, scoring 15 goals in a Flames sweater.
