CHICAGO BLACKHAWKS

All-Time Wild Record: 58-29-6 (31-12-3 at Grand Casino Arena, 27-17-3 at Chicago)

2025-26: Minnesota won the series-opening game, 4-3, in overtime at United Center (11/26)...LW Matt Boldy led the Wild with three points (1-2=3)...D Jonas Brodin (0-2=2) and D Brock Faber (1-1=2) each posted multi-point outings...G Filip Gustavsson saved 34-of-37 shots faced to earn the win for Minnesota...C Connor Bedard led the Blackhawks with two points (1-1=2)...C Jason Dickinson (1-0=1) and D Artiom Levshunov (1-0=1) also scored...G Spencer Knight stopped 20-of-24 shots faced for Chicago.

WILD LEADERS: RW Vladimir Tarasenko leads the Wild with 33 points (20-13-33) in 36 career games against Chicago...RW Mats Zuccarello owns 25 points (8-17=25) in 28 career matches...D Jared Spurgeon owns 21 points (7-14=21) in 46 games...LW Kirill Kaprizov owns 17 points (7-10=17) in 14 games.

WILD GOALIES: Gustavsson is 6-0-1 with a 1.99 GAA and a .929 SV% in seven career starts against the Blackhawks...G Jesper Wallstedt earned his first career win and shutout by saving all 24 shots faced at CHI (4/7/24) in the second start of his career (and only against the Blackhawks).

BLACKHAWKS LEADERS: LW Andre Burakovsky leads Chicago with 18 career points (4-14=18) in 30 games against the Wild...LW Teuvo Teravainen (4-10=14 in 26 games) and LW Nick Foligno (8-6=14 in 30 games) each own 14 points...C Ryan Donato has 11 points (4-7=11) in 23 games.

BLACKHAWKS GOALIES: G Spencer Knight is 0-0-1 with a 2.94 GAA and .867 SV% in two career games (one start) vs. the Wild...G Arvid Soderblom is 0-2-0 with a 3.55 GAA and a .889 SV%.

CONNECTIONS: C Ryan Hartman was selected by Chicago in the first round (30th overall) of the 2013 NHL Draft and collected 57 points (27-30=57) in 141 games during four seasons (2014-18) with the Blackhawks...C Vinnie Hinostroza is a Chicago native and was selected by Chicago in the sixth round (No. 169 overall) in the 2012 NHL Draft and collected 51 points (17-34=51) in 123 games...Donato tallied 39 points (18-21=39) in 84 games in parts of two seasons with Minnesota (2018-20)...D Wyatt Kaiser is from Andover and played three seasons at the University of Minnesota-Duluth (2020-23)...C Oliver Moore is from Mounds View and played collegiately at the University of Minnesota...Nick Foligno is the older brother of Wild LW Marcus Foligno.

FAST FACTS: Minnesota's 58 all-time wins against Chicago are its third-most against an opponent...The Wild has earned points in 17 consecutive meetings (16-0-1) against the Blackhawks dating back to 2/4/20...Minnesota has earned a point in 11 consecutive games played at Grand Casino Arena (10-0-1) dating back to 2/10/18...The Wild has earned points in nine consecutive games played at United Center (7-0-1) since 1/21/22...In 2015-16, the Wild became the first team to win every game in a season series of at least five contests against Chicago since the Boston Bruins went 8-0-0 in 1938-39.



CALGARY FLAMES

All-Time Wild Record: 45-47-17 (27-18-10 at Grand Casino Arena, 18-29-7 at Calgary)

2025-26: Minnesota won the series-opening contest, 2-0, in St. Paul (11/9), while Calgary won the second game, 4-1, at Scotiabank Saddledome (12/4)...LW Matt Boldy (1-1=2) and C Joel Eriksson Ek (0-2=2) lead the Wild with two points each...LW Kirill Kaprizov (1-0=1) and C Yakov Trenin (1-0=1) have also scored...G Jesper Wallstedt stopped all 26

shots faced to earn the shutout victory for Minnesota in the first game...G Filip Gustavsson stopped 27-of-30 shots faced in the second game...RW Matt Coronato (1-1=2) and D Rasmus Andersson (1-1=2) have also scored...G Devin Cooley saved 17-of-18 shots faced for Calgary in the first matchup...G Dustin Wolf stopped 26-of-27 shots faced for the Flames.

WILD LEADERS: RW Vladimir Tarasenko leads Minnesota with 24 points (9-15=24) in 32 games vs. Calgary...D Quinn Hughes has 23 points (4-19=23) in 30 games...D Jared Spurgeon owns 15 points (5-10=15) in 46 career games...LW Marcus Johansson owns 14 points (4-10=14) in 24 games.

WILD GOALIES: Gustavsson is 5-2-2 with a 1.90 GAA, a .938 SV% and two shutouts in 10 games (nine starts)...Wallstedt is 1-0-0 with a 36-save shutout in his lone start (11/9/25) against Calgary.

FLAMES LEADERS: C Mikael Backlund leads Calgary with 21 points (8-14=22) in 47 career matches against the Wild...C Nazem Kadri owns 20 points (9-11=20) in 39 games...LW Jonathan Huberdeau owns 17 points (8-9=17) in 25 games...D MacKenzie Weegar has 12 points (2-10=12) in 17 games.

FLAMES GOALIES: Wolf is 3-0-0 with a 2.47 GAA and a .892 SV% in four games (three starts) vs. Minnesota...Cooley is 0-1-0 with a 1.04 GAA and a .944 SV% in his lone start (11/9/25) against the Wild.

CONNECTIONS: RW Tyler Pitlick collected two assists in 25 games with the Flames in 2021-22.

FAST FACTS: The Wild is 15-11-3 in its last 29 games at the Saddledome after starting the all-time series 3-18-4.



EDMONTON OILERS

All-Time Wild Record: 65-33-10 (34-17-3 at Grand Casino Arena, 31-16-7 at Edmonton)

2025-26: Minnesota won the first meeting, 1-0, in Edmonton (12/3) and the second matchup, 5-2, at Grand Casino Arena (12/20)...LW Matt Boldy (2-0=2), C Nico Sturm (1-1=2), RW Vladimir Tarasenko (1-1=2) and RW Mats Zuccarello (0-2=2) each had two points...G Jesper Wallstedt saved all 33 shots faced to earn the shutout victory for the Wild in the first game...G Filip Gustavsson stopped 28-of-30 shots faced to earn a win in the second meeting...G Stuart Skinner stopped 23-of-24 shots faced in the game for Edmonton...G Calvin Pickard saved 32-of-36 shots faced in the second game.

WILD LEADERS: RW Mats Zuccarello leads Minnesota with 30 points (9-21=30) in 26 career contests vs. Edmonton...D Quinn Hughes owns 28 points (5-23=28) in 30 games...Tarasenko has 25 points (14-11=25) in 32 games...C Ryan Hartman has 18 points (8-10=18) in 23 games.

WILD GOALIES: Gustavsson is 3-2-0 with a 3.89 GAA and a .890 SV% in five career starts vs. Edmonton...Wallstedt is 1-0-0 with a shutout victory in his lone start against the Oilers (12/3/25).

OILERS LEADERS: C Connor McDavid (13-20=33 in 27 games) and C Leon Draisaitl (16-17=33 in 28 games) lead the Oilers with 33 career points each against Minnesota...C Ryan Nugent-Hopkins has 32 points (12-20=32) in 41 games...C Adam Henrique owns 24 points (8-16=24) in 34 games.

OILERS GOALIES: G Tristan Jarry is 5-0-1 with a 2.31 and a .921 SV% in six starts against the Wild...G Calvin Pickard is 4-5-0 with a 2.77 GAA, a .913 SV% and one shutout in nine games (eight starts) against Minnesota...G Connor Ingram is 2-3-0 with a 2.17 GAA and a .937 SV% in five starts.

CONNECTIONS: President of Hockey Operations and General

Manager Bill Guerin collected 161 points (79-82=161) and 354 PIM in 211 games with Edmonton in parts of four seasons (1997-01)...D Jared Spurgeon is from Edmonton...F Tyler Pitlick was selected by Edmonton in the second round (No. 31 overall) of the 2010 NHL Draft and collected 14 points (11-3-14) in 58 games across parts of three seasons (2013-15, 2016-17) with the club.

FAST FACTS: The Wild's 65 wins and 31 road wins all-time against the Oilers are its most against any team...The Wild's 33 victories at Grand Casino are the second-most against any franchise (COL, 35)...The Wild is 13-4-0 in the last 17 games against the Oilers dating back to 10/22/19...Minnesota is 37-13-1 (.735) vs. Edmonton since the 2010-11 season, the NHL's second-best point percentage against the Oilers in that span...Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Minnesota is 20-5-0 (.800) in 25 games at Edmonton, including an eight-game win streak (2/21/13-1/31/17) – the longest road win streak in team history...Minnesota has won seven of its last nine games against Edmonton at Grand Casino Arena dating back to 10/22/19...The Wild won 17 straight games against the Oilers in Saint Paul (2/25/07-10/13/11) - the longest home win streak against an opponent in franchise history.



MONTREAL CANADIENS

All-Time Wild Record: 23-8-3 (13-2-1 at Grand Casino Arena, 10-6-2 at Montreal)

2025-26: Montreal won the first meeting, 4-3, at Centre Bell (1/20)...LW Kirill Kaprizov (0-2=2), RW Vladimir Tarasenko (2-0=2) and RW Mats Zuccarello each posted multi-point outings...G Jesper Wallstedt stopped 20-of-33 shots faced...RW Ivan Demidov (0-2=2) and D Lane Hutson (1-1=2) each had two points...G Jakub Dobes saved 17-of-20 shots in the win for the Canadiens.

WILD LEADERS: LW Marcus Johansson leads Minnesota with 24 points (5-19=24) in 33 career games vs. Montreal...D Quinn Hughes owns 22 assists (0-21=21) in 20 games...Tarasenko has 17 points (5-12=17) in 26 games...LW Marcus Foligno owns 16 points (7-9=16) in 35 games.

WILD GOALIES: Gustavsson is 2-2-1 with a 2.93 GAA, a .899 SV% and one shutout in five starts against the Canadiens...Wallstedt is 0-1-0 after his lone start against Montreal on Jan. 20.

CANADIENS LEADERS: LW Patrik Laine owns 15 points (10-5=15) in 22 career games against Minnesota...LW Sammy Blais (7-3=10 in 16 games) and C Phillip Danault (5-5=10 in 24 games) each have 10 points...RW Brendan Gallagher owns eight points (5-3=8) in 19 games.

CANADIENS GOALIES: G Samuel Montembeault is 1-2-1 with a 3.23 GAA and a .885 SV% in four career starts vs. the Wild...Dobes is 1-1-0 with a 3.10 GAA and a .870 SV% in two starts.

CONNECTIONS: Wild F Tyler Pitlick collected three points (1-2=3) in 14 games with Montreal during the 2021-22 season...Minnesota Goaltending Coach Frederic Chabot went 1-4-1 with a 2.63 GAA and a .899 SV% in 16 games (seven starts) with the Canadiens in parts of four seasons (1990-91; 1992-94; 1998-99).

FAST FACTS: Minnesota is 18-2-0 in its last 20 games vs. the Canadiens and held a nine-game winning streak (since 10/20/19) until falling on Jan. 20...The Wild also recorded a nine-game win streak against Montreal from 12/3/14 - 1/7/19...Minnesota has won the last 11 games played at Grand Casino Arena (11/1/13 - 11/14/24), the team's longest active home win streak against an opponent and currently the fourth-longest active home winning streak w/ a single opponent in the NHL (Dallas, 12 games vs. Detroit; Carolina, 12 games vs. Buffalo; Colorado, 12 games vs. San Jose).
