The Calgary Flames continued a four game homestand on Thursday night by welcoming the New York Rangers to the Scotiabank Saddledome. It would take just 7:26 for the game's opening-goal, and it would be Matt Coronato who ripped home his sixth on the campaign to give the Flames an early lead, and they would keep that 1-0 advantage heading into the break. In the second, Yegor Sharangovich would double the home side's advantage with a one-timer he blasted over the shoulder of Igor Shesterkin. New York would score a pair before the end of the frame, to leave this game knotted at twos through 40. In the final stanza, Connor Zary would help the Flames reclaim the lead, as Dustin Wolf made 10 third period saves to help the Flames knock off the Rangers 3-2.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the first of three meetings this season between the Flames and Wild. Calgary collected points in two of their three meetings with the Wild in 2023-24, going 1-1-1.

This is a Pacific Division versus Central Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 2-2-0 against Central Division teams and a record of 5-5-1 against Western Conference opponents.

HUBY DOO:

With an assist on Connor Zary's third-period marker on Thursday night, Jonathan Huberdeau recorded his 500th NHL assist. Huberdeau becomes the third skater from the 2011 NHL draft to reach 500 NHL assists, joining Nikita Kucherov and the late Johnny Gaudreau, who had 399 with the Flames. The 31-year-old is also one of just 25-active NHL skaters to reach 500 assists.

SHARANGOVICH 300:

Flames forward Yegor Sharangovich appeared in his 300th NHL game on Thursday night. Sharangovich (1-1—2) would score a goal and register an assist to record his 36th multi-point game in his 300th career game. The Minsk, BLR native is just the sixth skater of Belarussian decent to skate in 300 or more NHL games in their career, joining; Ruslan Salei (917), Mikhail Grabovski (534), Andrei Kostitsyn (398), Sergei Kostitsyn (353), and Vladimir Tsyplakov (331). Sharangovich is the 10th player, and first drafted after the second round, in the 2018 draft class to reach the milestone.

WEEGSY BABY:

MacKenzie Weegar recorded three assists on Thursday against the Rangers for his first three helper night since March 16th, 2024 against Montreal. Weegar has recorded four three-assist games in his career and dating back to his Flames debut on October 13th, 2022 (a game in which he recorded two helpers), the Ottawa, ON native has recorded 67 assists, the fourth-most of any Flames skater over that span.

HOWLIN' FOR YOU:

With his 27-save effort on Thursday, Dustin Wolf extended his point streak to six games (5-0-1) dating back to November 5th in Montreal. Only four rookie goaltenders have posted a longer run with Calgary: Dan Vladar (13 GP in 2022-23), Rejean Lemelin (10 GP in 1980-81), Dan Bouchard (9 GP in 1972-73) and Mike Vernon (7 GP in 1986-87).

DOMESWEET DOME:

The Flames get set to wrap-up a four game homestand today against Minnesota. So far, the Flames have gone 3-0-0 on their four-game swing with wins over Nashville last Friday, and both the New York Islanders and Rangers earlier this week. So far in 2024-25, the Flames have posted an 8-3-0 record at the Scotiabank Saddledome, with their eight home wins being tied for the third-most in the league thus far.

CALGARY/MINNESOTA TIES:

Flames forward Andrei Kuzmenko and Wild forward Kirill Kaprizov were teammates in the KHL during the 2017-18 season with CSKA Moscow. Flames netminder Dan Vladar and Wild centre Jakub Lauko were teammates with the AHL's Providence Bruins for two seasons in 2019-20 and 2020-21.

AFTERNOON AFFAIRS:



The Flames get set to skate in their second matinee affair (Nov. 9 at BUF) of the 2024-25 season and first on home ice. Following tonight, the Flames next afternoon game will come next week on Nov. 29 in Columbus with puck drop at 3:00pm ET.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

On Thursday against the New York Rangers, the Flames recorded 20-plus shots in an opening period for the first time since Oct. 25, 2022 (20 vs. PIT).

Wild forward Ben Jones spent two seasons in the Flames organization with the AHL's Calgary Wranglers. The Waterloo, ON native scored 38 goals and 59 assists for 97 points in 143 games with the Wranglers.
