TEAM NOTES

- 🔑 The Tampa Bay Lightning defeated the New Jersey Devils 4-3 in overtime on Thursday night at AMALIE Arena.
- The Lightning have won back-to-back games in overtime and improved to 4-5 in overtime this season and 5-5 in games decided past regulation.
- Tampa Bay improved to 21-17-5 overall this season and 13-5-3 on home ice...The Bolts moved to 5-4-0 against Metropolitan Division opponents and 9-8-3 against Eastern Conference opponents.
- Tampa Bay's power play went 0-3 on Thursday night and have gone 0-9 over their last nine power-play attempts.
- Don Cooper won his 501st NHL game and passed Toe Blake for sole possession of the fifth-most wins with a single franchise in NHL
- The Lightning were outshot 30-20 by New Jersey, including a 10-6 deficit in the first period and an 8-4 deficit in the third period...Tampa Bay improved to 8-5-4 when outshot by its opponent this season.
- Tampa Bay's defense has combined for 83 assists this season the third most among all teams behind Vancouver (101) and Colorado (90). *Vancouver and Colorado's totals are entering play on Thursday

PLAYER NOTES

- Gage Goncalves played in his first career NHL game and had one hit and one takeaway in 9:00 time on ice.
- Luke Glendening scored two goals in the first period, his sixth and seventh of the season, giving the Bolts a 2-1 lead at the end of the first period...Glendening's second goal came shorthanded, marking the seventh shorthanded marker of his career and Tampa Bay's first shorthanded goal of the season...Through 43 games with the Lightning, Glendening (7-1-8, 43 GP) has already surpassed his point total from the 2022-23 season with Dallas (3-3-6, 70 GP)...Glendening notched his fifth-career, multi-goal game and his first since April 19, 2021.
- Dick Perbix notched two assists, marking his second consecutive multi-point effort and the eighth of his career...Perbix boosted his point total to 13 this season (1-12—13).
- Austin Watson tallied his first assist as a Bolt and his third point of the season (2-1-3) with an assist on Glendening's first goal.
- Brayden Point scored his 20th goal of the season (20-23—43 pts.)...Point has found the scoresheet in four of his last six games (4-1— 5) and has 13 points over his last 15 contests (8-5—13)...Point (7 from 2017-18 to 2023-24) scored and passed Kucherov (6 from 2014-15 to 2019-20) for the fourth-most consecutive 20-goal seasons in Lightning history.
- Darren Raddysh scored the game-winning goal in overtime, his first career overtime goal and his second career game-winning goal...Raddysh has three goals over his last four games.
- Nikita Kucherov picked up two assists, including one on the game winner...Kucherov tallied his 68th and 69th points of the season (28-41—69)...Kucherov has found the scoresheet in seven of his last eight games (5-7—12) and has eight multi-point efforts over his last 13 games (9-13—22)...Kucherov collected his 40th assist of the season and tied Victor Hedman (7) for the second most 40-assist seasons in Lightning history (Martin St. Louis tops the list with eight).
- Andrei Vasilevskiy stopped 27 of the 30 shots he faced to pick up his 11th victory of the season and improve to 11-9-0...Vasilevskiy also recorded an assist on the game-winning goal, marking his first assist of the season and the 19th of his career.
