NOTES:

SAN DIEGO has won three straight games and earned points in 11 of its last 13 games (9-2-2), including five straight games on the road (4-0-1) to improve to 18-18-7 on the season.

GLEN GAWDIN was named the AHL Player of the Week for the week ending in Feb. 11, 2024. He recorded a career-high 1-4=5 points, Feb. 10 @ Calgary, tying Sam Carrick (3-2=5; Nov. 25, 2018 @ STK) for the most points in a single game in Gulls AHL history. He also tied Kalle Kossila (0-4=4; Jan. 3, 2018 @ TEX) and Nikolas Brouillard (0-4=4; Dec. 14, 2022 vs. ABB) for the most assists in a single game in franchise history. Gawdin recorded three assists in the second period (0-3=3), tied for the most assists in a period in Gulls AHL history. He ranks second among San Diego leaders in points 14-19=33 and goals, recording 2-7=9 points through his last three games.

CHASE DE LEO recorded 2-2=4 points Feb. 9 @ Calgary, giving him 97 assists and 63-97=160 points as a Gull, surpassing Sam Carrick (95) for most assists in franchise history and Corey Tropp (63-94=157) for second-most points in franchise history. De Leo also tallied his 10th goal of the season Feb. 10 @ Calgary, tying Tropp (64) for second most goals in Gulls history. He now has 3-3=6 points through his last three games

TOMAS SUCHANEK co-leads the AHL with a .930 SV%. He stopped 38 shots to earn his second shutout of the season, Feb. 9 @ Calgary, becoming the fifth goaltender in Gulls history to record multiple shutouts in a season and the second rookie to achieve the feat (Lukas Dostal, 2 in 2021-22). He also stopped 45 shots to earn his seventh win in his last eight games (7-0-1), Feb. 10 @ Calgary. He improves to 11-2-2 on the season with a 2.25 GAA and .930 SV%.

OLEN ZELLWEGER helped the Pacific Division to a victory at the 2024 AHL All-Star Classic, co-leading the event with 0-3=3 points through four games. Since returning to San Diego after making his NHL debut with the Anaheim Ducks (0-1=1 in 4 GP), Zellweger has tallied 1-5=6 points through four games. He ranks second among AHL rookie defensemen in goals (9) and assists (22), while ranking third in points (9-22=31).

ANDREW AGOZZINO currently has the longest active point streak in the AHL at nine games (4-6=10) to pace San Diego in scoring (12-24=36) while ranking second in assists and third in goals.

YEGOR SIDOROV leads the WHL in GWG (10), ranks second in goals (42), third in PPG (14) and 15th in points (42-28=70). He leads Saskatoon in goals, PPG and GWG while ranking second on the team in scoring and fourth in assists. Sidorov is currently averaging 1.37 points per game and has 7-7=14 points through his last eight games.

CAREY TERRANCE ranks tied for third among OHL leaders in SHG (4) and leads the Erie Otters in goals (26), GWG (4), SHG and ranks third in points (26-19=45).

RODWIN DIONICIO ranks tied for fifth among OHL defensemen in goals (17) and ranks sixth in points (17-32=49). He also ranks second among Saginaw blueliners in points, goals and assists. Dionicio has 4-4=8 points through his last four games and is averaging 1.25 points per game this season.

CUTTER GAUTHIER co-leads the NCAA in goals (23) and is seventh in points (23-16=39) with a +16 rating in 27 games at Boston College (Hockey East). He leads the Eagles in goals, PPG (8), GWG (5) and shots (155). He currently has points in 15 of his last 16 NCAA games (15-13=30, +15). Since returning from the WJC, he has recorded 10 goals in 10 games (10-6=16, +10) including a hat trick on his 20th birthday (Jan. 19 vs. Merrimack; 3-0=3).

SAM COLANGELO is tied for seventh among NCAA leaders in goals (19) while earning a career-high 19-16=35 points this season. He has helped the Broncos to points in 17 of the last 19 games (13-2-4) while scoring 13-13=26 points in that span.
