ANAHEIM DUCKS COACHING STAFF



DALLAS EAKINS

HEAD COACH

Dallas Eakins completed his second season as head coach of the Anaheim Ducks in 2020-21, his sixth season within the organization. Eakins coached his 200th career NHL game Feb. 15, 2021 at San Jose. Named to his current post June 17, 2019, Eakins previously served as head coach for Anaheim's American Hockey League affiliate in San Diego from 2015-19. In his four seasons behind the bench, Eakins led the Gulls to a 154-95-23 record and three trips to the Calder Cup Playoffs. In addition, San Diego led the AHL Pacific Division in wins, points (331) and points percentage (.608) since the division's inception in 2015-16.

Eakins joined the Anaheim organization June 26, 2015 after serving as head coach of the Edmonton Oilers from 2013-15. Eakins previously spent four seasons as head coach of the AHL's Toronto Marlies (2009-13). In 584 career AHL games

with San Diego and Toronto, Eakins led his teams to a 311-209-64 record and five appearances in the Calder Cup Playoffs. Eakins helped San Diego advance to the 2019 Western Conference Finals and guided his 2011-12 Marlies club to an appearance in the 2012 Calder Cup Finals.

The Dade City, FL native guided the Marlies to the top of the North Division standings during his final two seasons behind the bench in Toronto while winning four of six playoff series. As a member of the Marlies, Eakins was named one of two head coaches to represent the Western Conference for the AHL All-Star Games for both the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons.

Selected by Washington in the 10th round (208th overall) of the 1985 NHL Draft, Eakins appeared in 120 career NHL games with the Winnipeg Jets, Florida Panthers, St. Louis Blues, Phoenix Coyotes, New York Rangers, Toronto Maple Leafs, New York Islanders and Calgary Flames. Eakins also played in the AHL and International Hockey League during his professional career, winning both the Calder Cup (2002) and Turner Cup (2000). His final professional season was with the Manitoba Moose (AHL) before retiring as a player May 26, 2004.

Eakins, his wife, Ingrid, and daughters, Emerson and Cameron reside in Coto de Caza.

MARK MORRISON ASSISTANT COACH

Mark Morrison finished his fourth season as an assistant coach for the Anaheim Ducks. Morrison joined the organization prior to 2017-18, a season in which the Ducks posted a 44-25-13 record for 101 points.

A native of Prince George, British Columbia, Morrison was previously with the Winnipeg Jets organization for six seasons as an assistant coach for the AHL Manitoba Moose (2015-17) and St. John's IceCaps (2011-15).

Prior to St. John's, Morrison served as head coach and general manager of the Victoria Salmon Kings of the ECHL, where he spent four years. He also coached and played with the Fife Flyers of the British National League, winning Coach of the Year honors three times.

Morrison played 10 NHL games with the New York Rangers from 1981-84, won the Adams Cup with the CHL's Tulsa Oilers and was named Most Sportsmanlike Player in the 1980-81 Memorial Cup. He also represented Canada at the World Junior Championships in 1982 (gold medal) and 1983.

Morrison has three children: son, Lance, and daughters, Nicole and Tara.



MARTY WILFORD ASSISTANT COACH

Marty Wilford concluded his third season as an assistant coach with the Ducks and his 10th season overall in the Anaheim organization. Wilford spent the previous seven seasons as an assistant coach with Anaheim's AHL affiliate in San Diego (2015-18), Norfolk (2012-15) and Syracuse (2011-12).

Wilford helped the Gulls to a 118-71-10-5 record in his three seasons in San Diego, including an appearance in the Pacific Division Finals in 2016 and 2017. From 2012-15, Wilford was part of a Norfolk coaching staff that led the Admirals to a 104-99-25 record and a win over top-seeded Manchester in the opening round of the 2014 Calder Cup Playoffs. Wilford made his professional coaching debut in 2011-12 at Syracuse, which went 37-29-10 and earned a berth in the 2012 Calder Cup Playoffs.

Originally selected by Chicago in the sixth round (149th overall) of the 1995 NHL Draft, Wilford collected 47-228-275 points with 573 PIM as a defenseman in 539 career AHL games from 2000-07. He ranked as Norfolk's all-time leading scorer among defensemen with 32-141-173 points in 318 games from 2000-05.

Wilford began his professional career in the International Hockey League, scoring 3-29-32 points in 186 games between 1997-00. He spent his final four seasons in Europe with Hamburg and Iserlong (Germany), and Fassa HC (Italy), notching 19-121-140 points in 146 contests. Wilford and his wife, Shelly, have three children: Emma, Grayce and Nash. The family resides in Irvine.

ANAHEIM DUCKS COACHING STAFF



SUDARSHAN MAHARAJ GOALTENDING COACH

Sudarshan “Sudsie” Maharaj (Sud-DARE-shun MAH-ha-raj) finished his fifth season as goaltending coach for the Anaheim Ducks. Under his leadership, the Ducks established a franchise-record with a .923 SV%, which co-led all NHL teams in 2017-18. In addition, both Ryan Miller (.928) and John Gibson (.926) surpassed the individual single-season franchise record for SV% (.924, Jonas Hiller in 2010-11, Gibson in 2016-17).

Maharaj joined the Ducks organization prior to the 2013-14 season in a consultant role focused on the club’s AHL affiliate in Norfolk, VA. Maharaj continued in the role throughout the team’s transition to San Diego for the 2015-16 season, where he helped Gulls goaltenders to a 39-23-8 record, 2.87 GAA, .906 SV% and a berth in the Calder Cup Playoffs.

A native of Trinidad, Maharaj spent eight seasons with the New York Islanders from 2003-06 (goaltending coach) and 2009-12 (goaltending consultant). He also helped develop the National Goaltending Development Program for Hockey Canada (2005-07) and served as goaltending consultant for the Korean national hockey team in preparation for the 2018 Olympic Winter Games.

Raised in Toronto from the age of six, Maharaj was a member of the 1984-85 National Hockey Championship York University team and played six seasons of pro hockey in Sweden.

Sudarshan and his wife, Yvonne, have two daughters, Alexandra (19) and Katherine (16).



LARRY BARRON SKATING SKILLS & DEVELOPMENT COACH

Larry Barron finished his third season as skating skills and development coach for the Anaheim Ducks. Prior to assuming his current role, Barron served as a skating consultant for the Ducks from 2013-18.

A native of Toronto, Ontario, Barron coached at the Under-16 and Under-18 levels from 2012-16, including Jr. Ducks 18AAA teams, and made two national championship appearances as head coach during that time.

With a 27-year background in youth hockey, Barron also owns Barron Hockey Academy in Lake Forest, Calif., which offers on-ice development and team training for local players ranging from amateur to professional backgrounds.

Barron resides in Ladera Ranch with his wife, Michelle, and their three children: Dillon (11), Peyton (9) and Brock (7).



JOE PISCOTTY VIDEO COACH

Joe Piscotty completed his 10th season as video coach, his 11th overall season with the organization. Piscotty originally joined the Ducks prior to the 2010-11 season as a video scouting analyst, assisting Hockey Operations with special projects before moving to his current role on Dec. 2, 2011.

Piscotty worked with the University of Michigan’s hockey team from 2006-08, serving as a graduate student manager under Head Coach Red Berenson. He was with the Wolverines when the club advanced to the Frozen Four in 2008. While at Michigan, Piscotty also earned a Master’s in Sports Management.

In addition, Piscotty served as a hockey operations assistant for the University of Denver’s men’s squad from 2008-10. He completed his time at Denver with a master’s degree in Business Administration (MBA). A native of Huntington Beach, Piscotty earned his bachelor’s degree in Business Administration from the University of Las Vegas, Nevada in 2006.

Joe and his wife, Carrie, reside in Huntington Beach with daughters, Kadence and Lea.



BRETT FERGUSON VIDEO COACH

Brett Ferguson concluded his 11th season with the Anaheim organization, his second as a video coach with the Ducks. Ferguson spent the previous nine seasons with Anaheim’s primary development affiliate in the American Hockey League, most recently with San Diego. He served four seasons with the Gulls from 2015-19, the first two years as video coach and the latter two as an assistant coach. Ferguson helped lead the Gulls to Calder Cup Playoff appearances in 2016, 2017 and 2019, advancing to the Pacific Division Final in all three years and the Western Conference Finals in 2019.

Born in Sioux City, Iowa and raised in West Des Moines, Ferguson spent five seasons as video coach with Anaheim’s AHL affiliates in Norfolk (2012-15) and Syracuse (2010-12). Ferguson, who began his professional coaching career as an assistant coach with Des Moines (USHL) in 2009-10, graduated from the University of South Carolina at Aiken in 2009 with a Bachelor’s degree in history.

Ferguson, his wife, Amanda, and their sons, Caleb and Aiden, reside in Irvine.

2020-21 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Appeared in his third NHL season with Anaheim, scoring 16-17=33 points with a +3 rating and 40 PIM in 55 games...set new NHL career highs in goals, assists, points, GWG (3), games played and TOI/game (15:28).
- Led the Ducks in goals, points, GWG (3), points-per game (.60), even-strength goals (15), even-strength points (29)...ranked second in shots (93) and tied for second in power-play points (4) and appearances (55), and was third in assists.
- Became the second-youngest player in Ducks history at 21 years, 120 days to lead the team in goals and scoring, behind only Paul Kariya's 18-21=39 points in 1994-95 (20 years, 199 days).
- Was the second-youngest NHL player to lead his team in scoring and goals, behind only Brady Tkachuk in scoring (OTT: 17-19=36) and Joel Farabee in goals (PHI: 20).
- Recorded a career-high three assists (all primary) in a 6-5 Ducks OT win, Mar. 8 vs. LAK.
- Set a career-high with two goals twice, including Feb. 5 vs. SJS (2-0=2) and Jan. 14 @ VGK (2-0=2).
- Registered a season-high three-game point streak from Feb. 9-15 (2-1=3).
- Became the 10th player in the NHL's modern era and 15th in NHL history (first Duck) to score each of his team's first three goals to begin a season, Jan. 16 @ VGK...was the first player to do so since Connor McDavid, Oct. 4, 2017 vs. CGY.
- Scored two goals (first career multi-goal/point game) in the first 7:58 of Anaheim's season-opener, Jan. 14 @ VGK, marking the fastest two goals by an NHL player to start a season in over 15 years...the last NHL player to score two goals in the first eight minutes of a season was Jeremy Roenick (LAK), who scored two goals in the first 4:18 on Oct. 5, 2005 @ DAL...became is the 11th player in NHL history to score two goals within the first eight minutes of a club's season, and marked the fastest two goals to start a season in Ducks history, besting Joffrey Lupul's two goals 22:19 into the season on Oct. 5, 2005 @ CHI.
- Finished the campaign leading all Ducks players 23-and-younger in career scoring (23-28=51) and goals, while ranking second in assists.

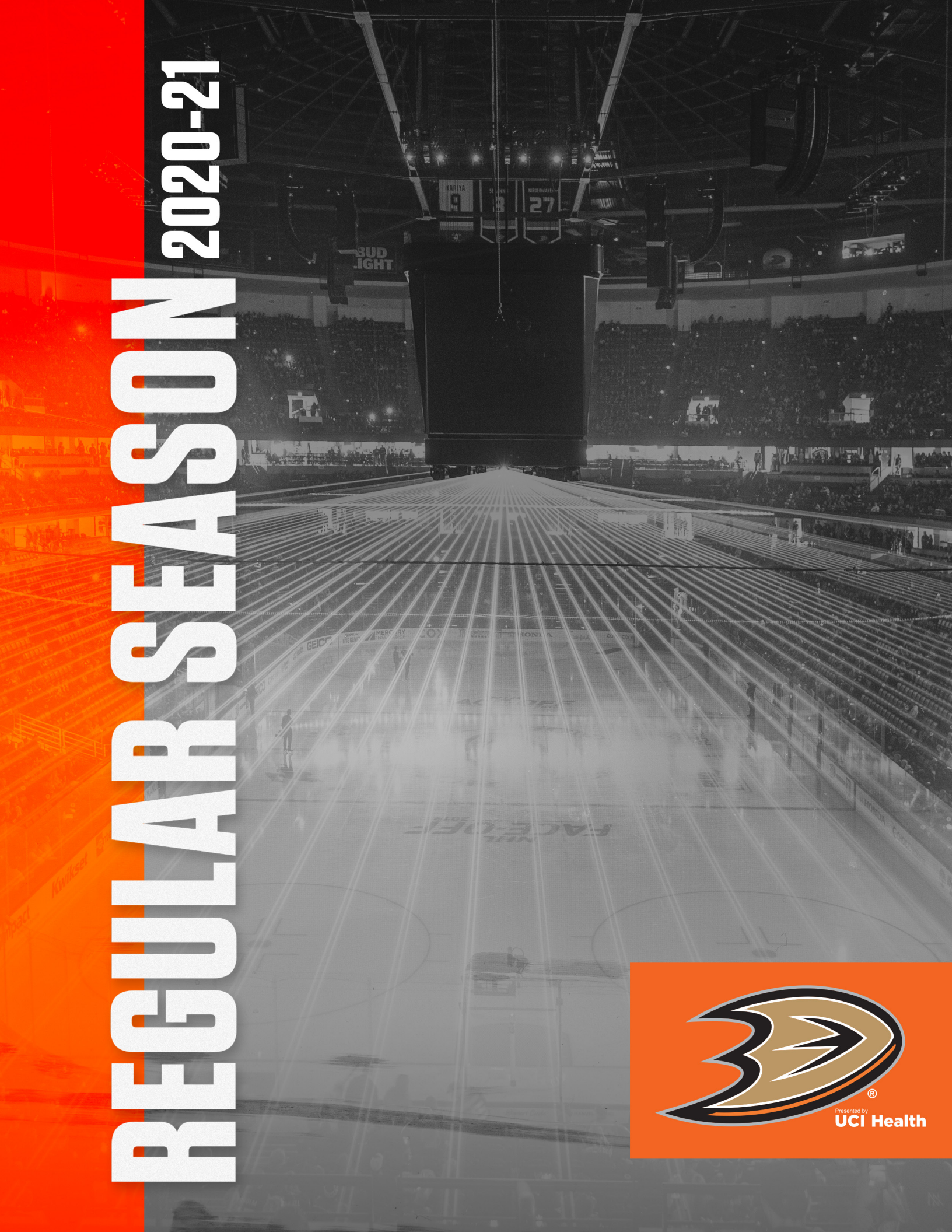

2020-21 SEASON IN REVIEW

THE 2020-21 SEASON: The Ducks concluded the 2020-21 season with a 17-30-9 record and 43 points...Anaheim completed the season with a 2-1-2 record the final five games in addition to points in five of the final seven contests (3-2-2)...the Ducks picked up points in seven of its 10 last road games (5-3-2) and went 7-4-2 the last 13 games away from home to conclude the season...the Ducks killed 43 of their last 49 penalties overall (87.8%) and 53-of-60 the final 20 games (88.3%)...Anaheim completed the campaign winning 50%-or-more of their draws in 36 of 56 games (64%), in addition to 21 of the final 30.

LEADING THE WAY: **Max Comtois** (16-17=33) led Anaheim in scoring and goals, and ranked second in assists...Comtois became the second-youngest player in Ducks history at 21 years, 120 days to lead the team in scoring, behind only Paul Kariya's 18-21=39 points in 1994-95 (20 years, 199 days)...he was also the second-youngest NHL player to lead his team in scoring and goals, behind only Brady Tkachuk in scoring (OTT: 17-19=36) and Joel Farabee in goals (PHI: 20)...**Cam Fowler** led Ducks defensemen in scoring (5-18=23), goals, assists and shots (75), marking the second straight season Fowler has led the club in points and goals...**Rickard Rakell** (9-19=28) paced Anaheim in assists and shots (144), ranked second in scoring and third in goals...Rakell became the first Ducks player to surpass Ryan Getzlaf as the team leader in assists in 14 seasons (Getzlaf led the club in assists for 13 straight seasons from 2007-08 to 2019-20)...**Anthony Stolarz** ranked eighth in SV% (.926) among qualified NHL goaltenders, posting a 3-2-0 his last five starts with one shutout, a 1.78 GAA and .938 SV%.

ONE-GOAL GAMES: Anaheim played in 29 one-goal games in 2020-21 (52%), Anaheim's highest percentage of one-goal games since 2010-11 and 2016-17 (54%, 44-of-82)...the 29 one-goal games ranked tied for second among NHL clubs in 2020-21, behind only St. Louis (31) and tied with Dallas...the Ducks tied a club record, playing in eight straight one-goal from Feb. 22-Mar. 8, 2021, matching the previous mark set Feb. 28-Mar. 19, 2009...only St. Louis had a longer streak of nine straight one-goal games in 2020-21 (Feb. 13-Mar. 12)...seventeen of Anaheim's 28 road games (61%) in 2020-21 were decided by one goal, the most among all NHL clubs and tied for the 10th highest percentage of one-goal games since 2010-11...Anaheim also played in a club record seven straight one-goal road games from Feb. 9-Mar. 6, surpassing the prior mark of six set on three prior occasions (last: Mar. 20-Apr. 7, 2016)...only St. Louis played in more consecutive one-goal road games in 2020-21 (eight, Feb. 13-Mar. 8).

MILLER'S TIME: **Ryan Miller** announced his retirement from the NHL at the conclusion of the 2020-21 season on Apr. 29...he retires as the all-time leader among American-born goaltenders in wins (391), second in shutouts (44) and games played (795), and is one of six goalies in NHL history to win 30 games in seven straight seasons (2006-12)...Miller is the only player in hockey history to be named the top goaltender in the NCAA, American Hockey League, Winter Olympics and the NHL...Miller won the 2010 Vezina Trophy as the NHL's top goaltender, was named the MVP and Best Goaltender in the 2010 Olympics, the 2005 AHL Baz Bastien Memorial Award as the AHL's best goaltender, and the 2001 Hobey Baker Award as the NCAA's top collegiate player...Miller appeared in 18 NHL seasons with Anaheim, Vancouver, St. Louis and Buffalo from 2002-21, posting a 391-289-88 record with a 2.64 GAA and .914 SV% in 796 career NHL games...all-time, Miller completed his career ranked 14th on the NHL's wins list, 12th in saves (21,665), and 18th in appearances and minutes (46,145:35)

MR. 700 and 1,100: **Ryan Getzlaf** recorded his 700th career assist Mar. 18 vs. ARI, becoming the 55th player in NHL history and the fourth active player to record 700 assists, joining Joe Thornton, Sidney Crosby and Nicklas Backstrom...Getzlaf leads Anaheim in career assists (703) and became the first member of the 2003 NHL Draft to reach 700 assists...he ranks fifth among NHL leaders in assists since entering the league in 2005-06, and tied for fourth with 380 primary assists since 2007-08...Getzlaf also became the 14th active player and the first in Ducks history to reach 1,100 career games May 5 @ STL.

TEENAGE DREAM: Rookies **Jamie Drysdale** (18 years, 344 days) and **Trevor Zegras** (19 years, 363 days) scored their first NHL goals 2:29 apart Mar. 18 vs. ARI...the two goals made Drysdale and Zegras the youngest set of teammates in NHL history to each score their first NHL goals less than 2:30 apart...Drysdale and Zegras are the second Ducks teammates 19 or younger to score in the same game, joining Oleg Tverdovsky (19) and Chad Kilger (18) Nov. 5, 1995 vs. NJD...Drysdale's goal came in his NHL debut, and he added an assist on Zegras' goal to become the third defenseman in NHL history to record multiple points in his NHL debut at age 18-or-younger (Petr Svoboda, MTL; Oct. 11, 1984 @ BUF & Ray Bourque, BOS; Oct. 11, 1979 @ WPG)...Drysdale's goal marked only the fourth time in NHL history an 18-year-old scored a goal in his NHL debut (Bourque in the aforementioned game, Scott Stevens, WSH; Oct. 6, 1982 @ NYR & Jason Doig, WPG; Oct. 7, 1995 vs. DAL)...at 18 years, 344 days, Drysdale became the youngest Ducks player in 25 years and the second-youngest player in franchise history to score a goal in his NHL debut (Chad Kilger, Oct. 9, 1995 @ WPG; 18 years, 316 days)...Drysdale is also the third-youngest Ducks defenseman in franchise history

to score a goal (fourth-youngest player overall) and is the youngest-ever player in franchise history to record two points in his NHL debut (1-1=2)... Zegras scored his first career NHL goal at 14:30 of the second period, becoming the third-youngest U.S.-born player to score a goal for Anaheim (10th-youngest player in club history).

KIDDING AROUND: Eleven players 23 or younger appeared in a game for Anaheim: Jamie Drysdale (18) Trevor Zegras (19), Isac Lundestrom (21), Simon Benoit (22), Max Comtois (22), Josh Mahura (22), Max Jones (22), Jacob Larsson (23), Sam Steel (22), Troy Terry (23) and Alex Volkov (23)...Comtois led the Ducks in goals (16) and scoring (33) and was the second-youngest player in the NHL to lead his team in scoring (Brady Tkachuk, OTT: 17-19=36) and goals (Joel Farabee, PHI: 20)...Drysdale ranked fifth among NHL rookies in TOI/game (19:35) and also finished second among Ducks blueliners in goals (3) and tied for second in points-per game (.33).

NHL DEBUTS: Trevor Zegras (19 years, 339 days) made his NHL debut Feb. 22 @ ARI, becoming the third-youngest American and eighth-youngest forward to appear in a game for Anaheim (12th-youngest all-time in franchise history)...**Jamie Drysdale** (18 years, 344 days) is the third-youngest defenseman and fifth-youngest Duck overall to make his NHL debut with the club, the fifth 18-year-old to appear in a game with the Ducks, Mar. 18 vs. ARI...the only defensemen in franchise history to make their debuts at a younger age were Oleg Tverdovsky (18 years, 258 days) and Cam Fowler (18 years, 307 days)...**Simon Benoit** (22 years, 221 days) made his NHL debut Apr. 28 @ LAK, the 60th player to play for both the Ducks and San Diego Gulls...Benoit began his professional career with San Diego on a one-year AHL contract in 2018-19.

HATS OFF: Isac Lundestrom scored his first career hat trick Mar. 1 vs. STL (3-0=3), becoming the second-youngest player in club history to score a hat trick (21 years, 115 days), behind only Sam Steel (21 years, 51 days on Mar. 26, 2019 @ VAN, 3-0=3)...he scored his goals at 5:04 of the first period, 0:34 and 15:16 of the third...Lundestrom is the 26th player to record a hat trick in franchise history, while netting the 58th for the club all-time...the hat trick also marks the 11th consecutive season a Ducks player has recorded a hat trick.

CALLING IT A CAREER: Anaheim Ducks Senior Vice President of Hockey Operations **David McNab** announced his retirement from the NHL on May 11...an original member of the Ducks, McNab completed his 43rd consecutive year in the NHL and 28th with Anaheim in 2020-21, working 3,532 regular season and playoff contests with Anaheim, the New York Rangers, Hartford Whalers and Washington Capitals...McNab retired as one of the longest-serving hockey executives with a single franchise...McNab was instrumental in helping the Ducks become the first team from California to win the Stanley Cup in 2007 and the first West Coast team to win the Stanley Cup since the 1925 Victoria Cougars (first U.S. team to win it since the 1917 Seattle Metropolitans)...his impact on the Ducks was significant, helping the club to two Stanley Cup Finals (2003 and 2007), three Western Conference Final appearances (2006, 2015 and 2017) and the Conference Semifinals in 2009 and 2014.
