Islanders forward **Bo Horvat** scored his first goal of the 2024 Stanley Cup Playoffs and 13th of his postseason career in Game Two on Monday. This season, the London, ON native recorded 33 goals, second on the team, passing the 30-goal mark for the third straight season. Horvat, 29, scored 17 goals and recorded 37 of his 68 points on home ice this season. He tallied a career-high six game-winning goals, four at UBS Arena, and the Islanders finished the 2023-24 regular season with an 18-4-7 record when Horvat found the back of the net.



SETH JARVIS #24

Carolina forward **Seth Jarvis** recorded a goal and two assists in Game Two on Monday night, his first career three-point game in the postseason. Jarvis, 22, has 21 career playoff points (nine goals, 12 assists), leading his 2020 NHL Draft class. The Winnipeg, MB native finished the 2023-24 regular season with seven points (five goals, two assists) in his final four road games. He scored two goals the last time he visited UBS Arena in the regular season on March 19, 2024, and in his most recent postseason visit to Belmont Park on April 23, 2023.
