PAVOL REGENDA recorded his team-leading fifth goal and second multi-point game (1-1=2) of the 2023-24 campaign, Oct. 27 vs. Abbotsford. With his assist Oct. 29 @ Henderson, he now has seven points through five games on the season (5-2=7) and co-leads the Gulls with a +4 rating.

CALLE CLANG made his third appearance of the season Oct. 29 @ Henderson, stopping 35-of38 shots, matching his AHL career-high in saves.

DREW HELLESON recorded his first goal of the season, Oct. 29 @ Henderson with **ANDREW AGOZZINO** tallying the primary assist for his 300th career AHL assist. He now has 220-300=520 points in 670 career AHL games with San Diego, San Jose, Belleville, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton, Colorado, San Antonio, Chicago and Lake Erie.

GLENN GAWDIN recorded his second goal of the season, Oct. 27 vs. Abbotsford. He also found the scoresheet Oct. 29 @ Henderson, for his second goal in as many games. Gawdin now ranks second among San Diego leaders in goal scoring (3).

TREVOR CARRICK tallied his team-leading fifth assist of the season, Oct. 29 @ Henderson, while **BLAKE MCLAUGHLIN** recorded his first career AHL assist.

BEN KING earned his first career AHL assist, Oct. 27 vs. Abbotsford. He now has two points through his first four professional games (1-1=2).

The blueliner ranks second on Windsor in points, is ranked tied for second in goals and co-leads the team in assists.

CAREY TERRANCE extended his point-streak to 11 games (9-7=16). He currently ranks tied for sixth among league leaders in goals (9) and 10th in points (9-9=18). The forward has points in 12 of 14 games on the campaign and leads Erie in points (9-9=18) and goals, while ranking tied for second in assists.

YEGOR SIDOROV has recorded 16 points through 12 games on the season (9-7=16) and a +7 rating. He leads Saskatoon in power-play goals (5), shots (60) and co-leads the team in goals while ranking third among team leaders in points.
