

**FLAMES LAST GAME RECAP****October 19, 2024 – CALGARY FLAMES [1] at SEATTLE KRAKEN [2] (OT)**[Game Summary](#) | [Event Summary](#)

The Calgary Flames headed to Seattle for a meeting with the Kraken on Saturday night. The Flames would score the only goal of the first with Blake Coleman netting his first of the season with nine seconds left in the opening frame, and Calgary led 1-0 through 20. The Kraken would tie things in the second and these clubs were deadlocked at two through 40. After a scoreless third, this game required overtime where Seattle would score the winner to knock-off the Flames 2-1.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the first of two meetings this season between the Flames and Penguins. Calgary and Pittsburgh split their two-game season-series in 2023-24 with the home team winning on both occasions.

This is a Pacific Division versus Metropolitan Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 1-0-0 against Metropolitan Division teams and a record of 1-0-0 against Eastern Conference opponents.

MAN-THA OF THE HOUR:

Anthony Mantha has skated in 499 NHL games and is looking to play his 500th NHL game tonight. Mantha was selected 20th overall in the 2013 NHL draft by Detroit and made his NHL debut on March 15th, 2016. He would skate in 10 games during the 2015-16 season, scoring two goals and totaling three points. Mantha can become the 28th player drafted in 2013 to reach 500 NHL games.

BAC-1K-LUND:

Mikael Backlund skated in his 995th NHL game on Saturday night in Seattle, and now just sits five games away from joining the 1,000-games club. Backlund's NHL debut came back on January 8th, 2009 and has skated in all 995 of his NHL games in a Flames sweater. The 35-year-old is looking to become the 19th player of Swedish descent to skate in 1,000 NHL contests and become one of four active-Swedish-born skaters with 1,000 games-played and join Nicklas Backstrom (1,105), Victor Headman (1,056), and Erik Karlsson (1,009).

SPECIAL TEAMS:

Calgary enters tonight's contest tied for the sixth-best power play in the league so far at 29.4%. The Flames have struck on the man advantage in four of their first five outings, with only four teams having scored more than their five power play goals so far in 2024-25.

HOWLIN' FOR YOU:

23-year-old Dustin Wolf improved to 2-0-0 in 2024-25 and 10-7-1 in his career with a 31-save effort in his last start against the Chicago Blackhawks. He became the fifth goaltender in Flames franchise history to register a double-digit win total in his career before celebrating his 24th birthday. The others: Pat Riggan (51), Trevor Kidd (50), Dan Bouchard (34) and Mike Vernon (34).

HUBY DOO:



With his assist on Calgary's game-winning goal against Chicago last Tuesday, Jonathan Huberdeau registered his 498th career helper. With two more assists, Huberdeau can join Nikita Kucherov and Johnny Gaudreau as one of just three players from the 2011 NHL draft to reach the 500-assist mark and become the 25th-active skater to achieve the feat.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Matt Coronato scored his first NHL goal against the Pittsburgh Penguins back on October 14th, 2023.

The Flames will wear their black alternate jersey nicknamed 'Blasty' for the first time this season. Following tonight, Calgary will dawn the black threads twice more this month on Thursday and Saturday and on 12 more occasions following that throughout the 2024-25 campaign.
