SAN DIEGO has earned standings points in four of its last five games (3-1-1), improving their record to 5-11-4.

OLEN ZELLWEGER leads AHL rookie blueliners in PPG (3) and co-leads in PPP (3-5=8). He also ranks tied for third among AHL defensemen in points (4-13=17) and tied for eighth in assists. Zellweger co-leads the Gulls in points and PPG and ranks second in assists.

ANDREW AGOZZINO co-leads the Gulls in points (4-13=17), ranks second in assists and matched his season-high for points in a single game (1-2=3) Dec. 6 at Milwaukee. Agozzino recorded a six-game road contest point-streak Oct. 29-Dec. 2 (2-6=8).

JUDD CAULFIELD recorded his first career AHL asssist Dec. 2 at Chicago and tallied his second helper in as many games for the first time in his career Dec. 3 at Chicago.

TOMAS SUCHANEK stopped 32-of-34 shots to earn his second win of his AHL career, Dec. 6 at Milwaukee. Suchanek has helped San Diego earn standings points in all of his first three AHL starts (2-0-1).

CALLE CLANG stopped 24-of-25 shots to earn his second win of the campaign, Dec. 2 at Chicago. He also made 21 saves in his second consecutive start Dec. 3 at Chicago.

JACOB PERREAULT ranks third among Gulls leaders in goals (6) and has recorded 2-5=7 points through his last seven contests.

CHASE DE LEO has recorded 2-4=6 points through his first five games of the season.

Anaheim's prospects invited to pre-tournament camps include defenseman **TRISTAN LUNEAU** (Canada, ANA 2nd round, 53rd overall), defenseman **NOAH WARREN** (Canada, 2022 ANA 2nd round, 42nd overall), forward **CAREY TERRANCE** (USA, 2023 ANA 2nd round, 59th overall) and defenseman **RODWIN DIONICIO** (Switzerland, 2023 ANA 5th round, 129th overall).

YEGOR SIDOROV ranks tied for second in the WHL in goals (25) and tied for second in PPG (9). His 25-10=35 points rank second among Saskatoon leaders and his goals pace the team.

CAREY TERRANCE leads the OHL in SHG (4) and ranks tied for third in goal scoring (21). He also leads the Erie Otters in points (21-12=33) and goals. Terrance has 3-0=3 points through his first three games in the month of December.

RODWIN DIONICIO ranks tied for third among OHL defensemen in goals (10) and ranks tied for eighth in points (10-18=28). He also co-leads Saginaw blueliners in goals, while ranking second in scoring and assists.
