SET TO SHOCK THE LIGHTNING

- Going into Thursday's game, the Flyers are looking to break the two road game losing streak at Tampa (0-2-0). The last time Philadelphia won in Tampa was 3-2 on Oct. 18, 2022.
- Forward **Morgan Frost** has five points (1q-4a) in the last four games against Tampa.
- Forward Joel Farabee has three points (0g-3a) in the last four games against Tampa.
- Defenseman Cam York has three points (2q-1a) in the last four games against Tampa
- Forward **Noah Cates** has two points (1g-1a) in the last two games against Tampa.
- Defenseman **Travis Sanheim** has two points (1g-1a) in the last two games against Tampa.

SPECIAL TEAMS SURGE

- The Flyers rank 15th in the NHL with nine power-play goals in 45 attempts (20.0%)
- The longest streak of consecutive games this season with power-play goals was four games, Oct. 11-17.
- Philadelphia scored at least one power-play goal (5g) in the first four games, Oct 11-17.
- Last season, the longest streak of consecutive games with power-play goals was five games, Jan. 6-13, 2024. Philadelphia has reached the five-game threshold 81 times since 1977-78 when power play stats started being recorded.
- Philadelphia ranks second in the league in the penalty minutes per game (11.5), however the Flyers rank third in the NHL with five power-play goals-against in 45 penalty kills (88.9%).
- Philadelphia tallied a shorthanded goal against Calgary (10/12).
- Last season, the Flyers led the NHL in shorthanded goals (16) and ranked fourth in the league on the penalty kill (83.4%).

WALKING ON ERR

- **Samuel Ersson** has allowed three-or-fewer goals in six of nine games played.
- The Swedish native posted his sixth career shutout in a 2-0 win at Boston (10/29), stopping all 25 shots he faced. He becomes the 17th Flyers goaltender to reach the milestone in franchise history.
- Per NHL Stats, Ersson became just the third Flyers goaltender to post a shutout in Boston, joining Antero Niittymaki (27 saves on Jan. 2, 2006) and Brian Boucher (21 saves on March 4, 2000).



- He stopped a season-high 28-of-31 shots in regulation against Vancouver (10/19).
- He earned his first win of the season on Friday (10/11), saving 24-of-26 shots in regulation/OT and 4-of-5 shots in the shootout.
- The win during the season-opener against Vancouver (10/11) marked the goaltender's fifth career shootout win to tie for fourth all-time among Flyers goaltenders in shootout wins.

CAPTAIN O' CAPTAIN

- Sean Couturier tallied two assists on Nov. 5 at Carolina.
- With his assist against Carolina on Nov. 5, he passes John LeClair for 13th in all-time assists in Flyers history with 311 assists.
- He tallied his second career regular season hat trick in his first career five-point game (3g-2a) on Saturday vs. Minnesota (10/26).
- The forward tallied his 500th career NHL point with his first goal on Oct. 26 against Minnesota. He is the 16th player in franchise history to surpass this milestone and the 11th NHL player to hit the 500 point-mark from the 2011 NHL Draft class.

BUZZIN' WITH BEEZER

- Joel Farabee owns three points (1g-2a) in the last five games.
- He has tallied two three-game point streaks this season, Oct. 27-31 and Oct. 11-17.
- He posted a three-game point streak (1g-2a) from Oct. 27-31.
- The 24-year-old owned three points (1g-2a) in the first four games of the season, Oct. 11-17.
- He tallied a power-play assist on Friday against Vancouver (10/11) to kick off the season. Per NHL Stats, with the assist, Farabee extended his career totals in season-opening games to three goals and five assists (5 GP). Only five players have more with the franchise: Bob Clarke (6g-11a in 15 GP), Bill Barber (10g-3a in 11 GP), Travis Konecny (7g-5a in 9 GP), Mark Howe (1g-9a in 10 GP) and John LeClair (5g-4a in 8 GP). FROSTING OVER

- Morgan Frost scored a goal against Carolina on Nov. 5 and owns two points (1g-1a) in the last four games.
- He is tied for fourth on the team in assists (5) and tied for fifth in points (6).
- He posted two assists against Edmonton (10/15), his first multi-point game this season.
- The forward scored the game-deciding goal in the shootout, his third shootout goal in his eighth career attempt at Vancouver (10/11).
- He ranks second on the team in career shootout goals (3).

KONNECT THE DOTS

- **Travis Konecny** tallied a four-point game (2g-2a) against Carolina on Nov. 5, his third multi-point game this season and 94th in his career.
- He owns five points (3g-2a) in the last five games.
- Five of his seven goals this season have been on special teams.
- The 27-year-old leads the team in goals (7), assists (7) and points (14).
- He tallied a three-game point streak (3g-4a) from Oct. 23-27.
- He notched his first career four-assist and five-point game (1g-4a) on Oct. 26 vs. Minnesota.
- The right-winger scored two goals (SH/PP), his first multi-point game at Calgary (10/12).
- He scored a shootout goal in the season-opener at Vancouver (10/11).

MAD ABOUT MICHKOV

- **Matvei Michkov** tallied an assist at Carolina (11/5) to become the 17th Flyers skater to reach 10 career points in 13 games or fewer. Over the past 30 years, only two Flyers skaters have accomplished the feat: James van Riemsdyk (9 GP in 2009-10) and Mike Richards (11 GP in 2005-06). (NHL Stats)
- He was named NHL Rookie of the Month for October (11/1).
- The right winger is tied for first among NHL rookies for most goals (4) and points (10) and ranks tied for third in assists (6).
- He ranks second in goals and points and tied for second in assists.
- He recorded a career-high three-game point streak twice this season: Oct. 12-17 (2g-2a) and Oct. 22-26 (2g-3a).
- The Russian native tallied his second consecutive multi-point game (1g-1a) on Oct. 26 vs. Minnesota.
- He notched his second career multi-point (1g-1a) at Washington (10/23).
- The forward became the first Flyers rookie since James van Riemsdyk (1g-6a in 2009-10) to record at least seven points through



his first seven NHL games. The only other teenage rookies to do so for the club are Peter Zezel (2g-6a in 1984-85), Eric Lindros (4g-3a in 1992-93) and Rich Sutter (5g-2a in 1983-84). (NHL Stats)

- Per NHL Stats, he has spent 44.8% of playing time in the offensive zone the highest percentage among top five highest-scoring rookies this season (via NHL EDGE) (10/22).
- He recorded a career-high three-game point streak (2g-2a), Oct. 12-17.
- The 19-year-old tallied his first and second NHL goals, both while on the power play, his first multi-goal and multi-point game in his career (10/15 at EDM).
- He is the first Flyers rookie to score multiple power-play goals since Nolan Patrick on April 3, 2018 at NY Islanders.
- The forward posted his first NHL assist/point against Calgary (10/12).
- He posted four shots and blocked one shot in 18:32 ice time in his NHL debut on Oct. 11 against Vancouver.

SANNY SIDE UP

- Travis Sanheim owns four points (2g-2a) in the last five contests.
- He leads all Flyers defensemen in goals (3), assists (3) and points (6).
- He notched three points (2q-1a), his first multi-point appearance of the season, against Montreal (10/27).
- The defenseman logged a season-high 27:49 time on ice on Oct. 26 vs. Minnesota (10/26).
- He scored his first goal of the season against Washington (10/22).

TIPP OF THE HAT

- Owen Tippett owns three points (1g-2a) in the last five games.
- He ranks second on the Flyers in assists (6) and tied for third in points (8).
- He tallied a multi-point game (1g-1a) against Carolina (11/5), his third this season and 35th in his career.
- The right winger posted a three-game point streak (1g-4a) from Oct. 23 27.

BLUELINE BRILLIANCE

- In the last six games, the Flyers have had 11 points (4g-7a) from defensemen.
- Emil Andrae notched his first NHL assist/point at Boston (10/29).
 - He became the 25th Swedish-born player and 16th Swedish defenseman to tally a point for the Flyers franchise.
- Travis Sanheim owns four points (2g-2a) in the last five contests.
 - He notched three points (2q-1a), his first multi-point appearance of the season, vs. Montreal (10/27).
 - He logged a season-high 27:49 time on ice on Oct. 26 vs. Minnesota (10/26).
 - He scored his first goal of the season against Washington (10/22).
- Jamie Drysdale logged a Flyers career-high 25:03 TOI on Oct. 27 vs. Montreal.
