

**FLAMES LAST GAME RECAP****March 30, 2024 – CALGARY FLAMES [4] vs. LOS ANGELES KINGS [2]**[Game Summary](#) | [Event Summary](#)

The Calgary Flames welcomed the Los Angeles Kings to the Scotiabank Saddledome to start a brief two-game homestand on Saturday night. Nazem Kadri would open the scoring 4:45 into the game before LA tied things under a minute later. Martin Pospisil would score midway through the frame to give the Flames a 2-1 lead, and that is how this game looked through 20. Blake Coleman would net his 29th of the year in the second to give the Flames a two-goal cushion, but Anze Kopitar would get one back for the Kings to make it 3-2 through 40. MacKenzie Weegar would rifle home a powerplay marker midway through the third, and the Flames prevailed 4-2.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the second of three meetings this season between the Flames and Ducks. The Flames won matchup number one 3-0 on December 21st.

This is a Pacific Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 10-8-1 against Pacific Division teams and a record of 20-19-2 against Western Conference opponents.

LAST MEETING:

The Calgary Flames headed to Anaheim on December 21st to face the Ducks as part of a two-game California swing prior to the Christmas break. The Flames would open the scoring early in the first with Nick DeSimone scoring his first NHL goal to give Calgary an early 1-0 lead. In the second, Elias Lindholm would score a power play marker to double the Flames advantage through 40. In the final frame, Jacob Markstrom continued to stay white-hot, stopping all 25 shots he faced in the contest, while A.J. Greer added an empty netter, and the Flames left the Honda Center with a 3-0 win.

NAZ-HIM KADRI:

With a goal and an assist in Calgary's 4-2 win over Los Angeles on Saturday, Nazem Kadri recorded his 13th multi-point game with the Flames. The only player who has as many for the franchise since Kadri joined the team in 2022-23 is Elias Lindholm (14).

THE KUZMENKSHOW:

With his two assists in Saturday night against Los Angeles, Andrei Kuzmenko has now registered four points over his last two games (2G, 2A). Kuzmenko has now recorded eight multi-point efforts this season, and skated in 19:05 of ice-time against the Kings which is the most he's logged in a game since being acquired by the Flames.

WEEGSY BABY:

With his third period tally against the Kings on Tuesday, MacKenzie Weegar scored his 18th goal of the season. Recently, Weegar tied Al MacInnis (16 in 1987-88) for the most even-strength goals in a season by a Flames blueliner with 16 such markers. The Ottawa, ON native's 18 goals are the third-most in the league among defenceman, with only Roman Josi (19) and Cale Makar (19) lighting the lamp more and his 16 even-strength tallies lead all NHL blueliners. Weegar is now two goals away from becoming the first Flames rearguard to post a 20-goal season since Mark Giordano did during the 2015-16 campaign.

ON THE FARM:



The Calgary Flames AHL affiliate the Calgary Wranglers clinched a playoff spot for the second-straight season on Saturday night. The Wranglers currently sit in fifth place in the AHL's Pacific Division but are within three points of second place Tucson. The Wranglers have just six games remaining in their regular season with two in Bakersfield, two at home against Abbotsford, and will close out the season on the road in Abbotsford.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Jacob Markstrom made 25 saves in these clubs' first meeting for his first shoutout of the season. Markstrom also recorded the 200th win of his career, becoming just the third Swedish-born goaltender in NHL history to record 200 career wins, joining Henrik Lundqvist (459) and Tommy Salo (210). Markstrom also joined Braden Holtby (299) as the only goalies from the 2008 draft to reach 200 wins in the NHL.

The Flames have a record of 9-0-1 this season when Nazem Kadri and Blake Coleman both score in the same game with the pair both finding the back of the net in the same on Saturday against Los Angeles. Coelman has a team-leading 29 goals, while Nazem Kadri's 24 goals are the third-most on the Flames.
