TERM NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Lightning were defeated 6-2 by the New York Islanders on Thursday night UBS Arena.
- The Bolts fell to 27-20-5 overall and to 10-15-2 on the road...Tampa Bay moved to 7-6-0 against Metropolitan division opponents and to 12-11-3 against Eastern Conference opponents.
- Tampa Bay was outshot by New York 24-20, including a 14-3 deficit in the first period...The Lightning moved to 10-8-4 when outshot by their opponent this season.

PLAYER NOTES

- Woah Dobson gave the Islanders a 1-0 lead at 4:07 of the first period.
- Nikita Kucherov tied the game at 6:42 of the first period, tallying his 87th point of the season (33-54—87)...Eight of Kucherov's 33 goals this season have come by means of a slap shot, tied with Evan Bouchard for the second most among all players and trailing only Drew Doughty (9)...Kucherov extended his point streak to six games (5-7—12).
- Darren Raddysh recorded the lone assist on Kucherov's goal, marking his 19th point of the season (4-15—19)...Raddysh has four ppoints over his last five games (1-3—4).
- Mathew Barzal and Kyle Palmieri each scored a goal within the final six minutes of the first period to give New York a 3-1 lead at the end of the opening frame.
- **Brandon Hagel** extended his point streak to five games (5-2—7) with his 18th goal and 45th point of the season...Hagel is one game shy of tying his career-long, six-game point streak (3-5—8, 6 GP Jan. 10-19, 2023)...Hagel has pointed in 11 of his last 13 games (8-7—15).
- Anthony Cirelli tallied the primary assist on Hagel's goal, marking his 26th point of the season (10-16—26)...Cirelli has posted nine points (2-7—9) over his last eight games.
- Victor Hedman logged the secondary assist on Hagel's goal...Hedman recorded his 42nd assist and 51st point of the season...Hedman has found the scoresheet in seven of his last nine contests (3-9—12).
- Ryan Pulock, Bo Horvat and Casey Cizikas scored three unanswered goals in the second period, extending New York's lead to 6-2.
