Leads all Big Ten skaters in plus/minus and face-offs won (331), ranks T-2nd in points, third in goals and T-3rd in assists...Owens 17 points (10-7=17) and plus-10 rating in last 10 games...Had hat trick on Jan. 31 at Penn State...Scored two goals in two consecutive games (Dec. 28-29) and was named Great Lakes Invitational MVP...Was named Big Ten Third Star of the Week on Nov. 11...2023 first-round selection.

Ranks third on team in assists, fourth in goals and points...Has 16 points (8-8=16) in last 10 games...Had hat trick on Jan. 11 at Windsor...Named OHL Player of the Week on Oct. 20 after posting seven points (1-6=7) in three games...Tallied four-point game (1-3=4) on Sept. 27 vs. Sudbury...Recorded eight points (1-7=8) and a plus-4 rating at the IIHF World Junior Championship and won a silver medal with team Czechia...He ranked T-4th among all skaters in assists and T-9th in points 2025 fourth-round selection.
