All-Time Wild Record: 24-29-12 (13-10-9 at Xcel Energy Center, 11-19-3 at Detroit)

2022-23: Minnesota went 1-1-0 in the season series...The Wild fell to Detroit, 2-1, in the series opener (12/29) and won the second meeting at Xcel Energy Center, 4-1 (12/14)...C **Freddy Gaudreau** led Minnesota with three points (2-1=3)...LW **Kirill Kaprizov** (1-2=2) and RW **Mats Zuccarello** (1-1=1) each had two points...G **Filip Gustavsson** went 1-1-0 in two starts with a 1.53 GAA and a .929 SV%...LW **Lucas Raymond** (2-0=2), C **Dylan Larkin** (0-2=2) and LW Adam Erne (0-2=2) two points each...G **Ville Husso** stopped 30-of-31 shots faced for Detroit in the first meeting...G Magnus Hellberg saved 18-of-21 shots in the second meeting.

WILD LEADERS: Zuccarello leads Minnesota with 17 points (6-11=17) in 22 games against Detroit...LW **Marcus Johansson** has 15 points (4-11=15) in 29 games...D **Alex Goligoski** owns 10 points (1-9=10) in 25 contests... LW **Pat Marcon** has nine points (5-4=9) in 29 games...C **Joel Eriksson Ek** owns eight points (3-5=8) in 10 matches.

WILD GOALIES: G **Marc-Andre Fleury** is 12-9-1 with a 3.32 GAA, a .894 SV% and one shutout in 22 career starts against the Red Wings...Gustavsson is 1-1-0 with a 1.53 GAA and .929 SV% in two starts againts Detroit.

RED WINGS LEADERS: LW **David Perron** leads the Red Wings with 38 points (15-23=38) in 47 games against the Wild...LW **J.T. Compher** has 15 points (7-8=15) in 26 games...Larkin owns 13 points (3-10=13) in 14 contests... RW **Alex DeBrincat** owns 11 points (6-5=11) in 17 games.

RED WINGS GOALIES: Husso is 6-0-0 with a 2.43 GAA, a .923 SV% and one shutout in six career starts against Minnesota...G **Alex Lyon** is 1-0-0 with a 3.00 GAA and a .906 SV% in his lone start vs Minnesota...G **James Reimer** is 8-5-1 with a 2.45 and a .921 SV% in 15 games against Minnesota.

CONNECTIONS: D **Jon Merrill** collected five assists in 36 games with the Red Wings in 2020-21...Detroit Head Coach **Derek Lalonde** was Head Coach of the lowa Wild for two seasons (2016-18)...Red Wings Assistant Coach **Alex Tanguay** spent two seasons as an Assistant Coach for the lowa Wild (2019-21)...D **Justin Holl** hails from Tonka Bay and played four seasons at the University of Minnesota (2010-14)...Lyon is from Baudette.

FAST FACTS: Minnesota is 12-6-3 in its last 21 games against Detroit with 10 of those games decided by one goal...The Wild has earned a point in seven of its last 10 games in Detroit (5-3-2)...Minnesota has earned a point in 16 of the last 19 meetings at Xcel Energy Center (10-3-6) and is 6-0-1 in the last seven games played in Saint Paul.

NOTES & MILESTONES

Jonas Brodin: Skated 29:46 at OTT (11/18), the second-highest single-game TOI total of his NHL career.

Marc-Andre Fleury: Made 24 saves at NYR (11/9) to reach 25,808 career saves and pass Patrick Roy (25,800 career saves) for third most in NHL history...Currently at 547 career wins, needs five wins to pass Roy (551 career wins) for second-most in NHL history...Earned the 65th shootout victory of his career vs. NYR (11/4), further extending his own NHL record.

Joel Eriksson Ek: Leads Minnesota with nine goals and five PPGs this season...Reached 100 career goals by scoring a PPG at BUF (11/10), becoming the 11th player in franchise history to reach the landmark.

Kirill Kaprizov: With a goal vs. COL (11/24), reached 120 career goals and surpassed Andrew Brunette (119 goals) for sole possession of fifth-most in franchise history.

Marco Rossi: T-2nd among NHL rookies in goals (six), T-4th in points (6-5=11) and T-5th in shots (35)...Owns an active four-game point streak (1-3=4), a career long.

Jared Spurgeon: Currently with 110 career goals, tied with Nino Niederreiter for eighth-most in franchise history, needs one goal to tie Eric Staal for seventh-most in franchise history.

Mats Zuccarello: Leads the Wild with 20 points and 15 assists this season... Recorded the 400th assist of his NHL career at OTT (11/18), becoming the first Norwegian-born player to reach the mark...Owns an active five-game point streak (2-5=7)...Has recorded a point in nine consecutive home games (5-7=12) to open the season, a franchise record.



PLAYER NOTES



KIRILL THE THRILL

- Kirill Kaprizov is second on the Wild with 17 points and four PPGs this season (6-11=17).
- Kaprizov scored the 120th goal of his career vs. COL (11/25) to move past Andrew Brunette (119 career goals) for fifth-most in franchise history.
- Currently with 43 career PPGs, Kaprizov scored the 40th PPG of his career at MTL (10/17) to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach 40 career PPGs. He joined Zach Parise (69), Mikko Koivu (60), Marian Gaborik (59) and Andrew Brunette (55).
- Kaprizov recorded the 22nd three-point game of his career vs. EDM (10/24, 0-3=3). Only two players have more such games in a Wild sweater (Mikko Koivu, 34 and Marian Gaborik, 29).
- Kaprizov led the Wild with 75 points (40-35=75) last season.
- The left winger led the Wild in both multi-goal games (seven) and three-point games (seven) was tied for first in multi-point games (18).
- Kaprizov recorded his 100th career goal at CAR (1/19/23), becoming the third-fastest active player to reach that mark (180 games), trailing Patrik Laine (179 games) and Alexander Ovechkin (167 games).
- Kaprizov was the first player in Wild history to record his first 200 career points with the franchise in fewer than 200 games.

STONE-COLD KIRILL-ER

- Kaprizov's game-winning goal in overtime vs. CBJ (2/26/23) marked his sixth overtime goal since entering the NHL in 2020-21. The total is tied for seventh-most in the league since the start of the 2020-21 season.
- Kaprizov currently stands at 10 career overtime points in a Wild sweater, tied with Pierre-Marc Bouchard and Marian Gaborik for second-most in franchise history.

 Kaprizov is tied for first in franchise history with six OT goals, matching teammate Matt Dumba. Six of his 13 career game-winning goals have come in overtime.



MATS-TER OF HIS CRAFT

- Mats Zuccarello leads the Wild with 20 points (5-15=20) and 15 assists this season.
- Owns an active five-game point streak (2-5=7) and an active nine-game home point streak (5-7=12), the longest in Wild franchise history to start a season and the longest home point streak of Zuccarello's career
- Recorded the 400th assist of his NHL career against OTT in Sweden (11/18), becoming the first Norwegian player to reach the mark.
- Zuccarello started the season on a six-game point streak, his longest point streak to open a season and tied for the second-longest seasonopening point streak in franchise history.
- The 36-year old Norwegian's 20 points this season ranks third in the NHL among players age 33 or older, while his 15 assists lead all players in the same age range.
- Zuccarello posted 22-45=67 during the 2022-23 season, leading the team in assists, ranking second in points and fourth in goals.
- Zuccarello ranks second among active undrafted NHL players in career points (593), third in career goals (191) and third in career games played (784).

PLAYER NOTES

SPURGEON GENERAL

- Jared Spurgeon led the Wild with 179 blocked shots, 25.6 shifts per game and a plus-32 rating last season.
- His single-season blocked shot total ranked third in franchise history behind Greg Zanon (212, 2010-11 season; 196, 2009-10 season).
- He finished sixth in the NHL in blocked shots during the 2022-23 season
- His plus-32 rating ranked 12th in the NHL and fourth in the Western Conference. Among defenseman, Spurgeon was sixth in the NHL and second in the Western Conference.
- His plus-110 career rating is first in Wild history.
- Spurgeon has played the second most games in franchise history sits third on the team's all-time assist list.

- The Edmonton native was named the second full-time captain in team history on Jan. 3, 2021.
- He is the franchise leader in goals, points, shots on goal, PPG, GWG and blocked shots by a defenseman and ranks second in assists, PPA, PPP, and hits among defensemen.



CROWN JOEL

- Joel Eriksson Ek reached 100 career goals by scoring a PPG at BUF (11/10), becoming the 11th player in franchise history to reach the milestone.
- Set a new career high with 23:53 of TOI at OTT (11/18) in Stockholm, Sweden.
- Won 19-of-23 faceoffs (83%) at BUF (11/10), tying his career high (10/19/21 vs. WPG, 19-of-25).
- Eriksson Ek (9-7=16) currently leads the team in goals, PPGs (five) and shots on goal (63) and is third on the team in scoring this season.
- Eriksson Ek has recorded five multi-point games this season, tied for the team lead
- Eriksson Ek scored two PPGs at MTL (10/17), marking the second time in his career recording multiple PPG in a single game (two PPG vs. WPG, 10/19/21).
- Eriksson Ek scored the 30th PPG of his career vs. COL (11/24) to move past Pierre-Marc Bouchard (29 PPGs) for sole possession of eighth on Minnesota's all-time list.

MARCO POLO

- **Marco Rossi** is currently T-2nd among NHL rookies in goals (six), T-4th in points (6-5=11) and T-5th in shots (35).
- Rossi owns an active four-game point streak (1-3=4), a career long.
- He scored the first goal of his NHL career at TOR (10/14), becoming the ninth Austrian-born player to score a goal in a NHL regular-season game.
- Rossi joined Thomas Vanek (39 goals with Minnesota) and Christoph Brandner (four goals with Minnesota) as the only Austrian-born players to score goals for the Wild.

SHOT THROUGH THE HART

- **Ryan Hartman** is second on Minnesota with seven goals this season and is tied for fourth on the team with 11 points (7-4=11).
- Hartman was awarded the NHL's Third Star of the Week for the week ending Oct. 29 after ranking second in the NHL with five goals (5-2=7) in four appearances.
- Recorded five points (3-2=5) vs. EDM (10/24), marking his second career hat trick (first with MIN) and tying his career-best in points in a game.

PLAYER NOTES



THE MOOSE IS LOOSE

- Marcus Foligno is ninth in the NHL with 54 hits this season. He led Minnesota with 237 hits last season.
- Foligno has recorded five 200-hit seasons in his career, including three with the Wild.
- His 3.6 hits per game played were tied for seventh-most in the NHL last season (min. 50 games played).
- Since entering the league in 2011-12, Foligno ranks eighth among NHL players with 2,236 hits.

PHONE BOOTH FREDDY

- Freddy Gaudreau finished tied for third in the NHL with four shorthanded goals and tied for sixth in shorthanded points during the 2022-23 season.
- Became the first player in Wild history to record multiple shorthanded goals in a single game, netting two at COL (3/29).
- Gaudreau led the NHL with eight shootout goals last season, tied for the largest since-season total in Wild history (Mikko Koivu, 2006-07 season).

BROCKED AND LOADED

- Brock Faber leads all rookie skaters with 23:14 in time on ice per game and 31 blocked shots. He ranks third among rookie defensemen in scoring (1-7=8), while his plus-five rating ranks T-2nd among rookie skaters and leads all rookie defensemen.
- Faber scored his first NHL goal and recorded his first NHL point with a first-period goal vs. FLA (10/12).
- Faber made his NHL debut with the Wild at CHI (4/10), leading the team in time on ice (21:49) and blocked shots (six) while recording a plus-one rating and one shot on goal.
- Faber's six blocked shots were tied for most among players making their NHL debut since the league began tracking the stat in 2005-06.
- He is one of 33 Minnesota-born players (31 skaters) to wear the Wild sweater in a regular-season game.



IN FULL BLOOM

- Goaltender Marc-Andre Fleury made 24 saves at NYR (11/9) to reach 25,808 career saves and pass Patrick Roy (25,800 career saves) for third most in NHL history.
- Fleury made his season debut at MTL (10/17), making 27 saves in the 5-2 win and improving his record to 27-13-6 all-time against the Canadiens.
- Currently at 247 career wins, needs four wins to tie (five to surpass)
 Roy (551 career wins) for second-most all-time.
- Fleury played 58:31 vs. LAK (10/19), moving his career minutes total to 57,164:32 and surpassing Terry Sawchuk (57,155:51) for fourth on the all-time list among NHL goaltenders.
- Fleury notched the 65th shootout win of his career vs. NYR (11/4), further extending his all-time NHL record.
- Finished 24-16-4 for the 2022-23 season, Fleury recorded his 15th career season of 20-plus wins, tied for third-most in NHL history: Patrick Roy (17), Martin Brodeur (16) and Ed Belfour (15).
- With 73 career shutouts, Fleury has recorded a shutout against 29-of-32 NHL teams (St. Louis, Vegas and Minnesota), the most in league history.
- Currently at 994 career games played, Fleury played in his 972nd career game vs. VGK (2/9) to move past Terry Sawchuk for fourth place in NHL history among goalies. Roy currently ranks third with 1,029 career game appearances.
- Fleury faced his 28th career penalty-shot attempt at MTL (10/25). Per NHL Stats, Fleury's 22 saves on 28 all-time attempts trail only Roberto Luongo (33 PS SA, 29 PS saves) for the all-time lead in both categories.
