TEAM NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Lightning defeated the St. Louis Blues 6-1 on Tuesday night at AMALIE Arena.
- Tampa Bay improved to 15-13-5 overall and to 9-3-3 on home ice...The Bolts moved to 4-6-1 against Central Division opponents and 9-8-2 against Western Conference opponents.
- The Lightning scored the game-opening goal for the seventh time over their last eight games and improved to 11-5-0 this season 0 when doing so.
- Tampa Bay outshot St. Louis 33-29 and boosted its record to 10-9-1 when outshooting its opponent.
- The Bolts won their third-consecutive home game.
- The Bolts improved to 4-4-2 over their last 10 games against St. Louis and 6-3-1 over their last 10 meetings at AMALIE Arena.
- Tampa Bay's power play has converted on five of their last 12 opportunities (42%) at AMALIE Arena.
- The Lightning and AMALIE Arena recorded their 345th consecutive sellout.

PLAYER NOTES

- Michael Eyssimont scored his first goal in 20 games (since Nov. 7 at MTL) to give the Lightning a 1-0 lead at 2:23 of the first period...The goal marked Eyssimont's 11th point of the season (5-6—11).
- Tyler Motte notched his second goal of the season (2-1—3) to give Tampa Bay a 2-0 lead at 17:10 of the first period.
- Nikita Kucherov scored his 21st and 22nd goals of the season, marking his eighth multi-goal game of the season and the 44th of his career...Kucherov extended his home point streak to eight games (7-7—14)...Kucherov has posted five goals and 10 points over his last five games...Kucherov has picked up nine points over his last five games versus St. Louis (3-6—9) and has found the scoresheet in five of his six career home contests vs. STL (3-6—9).
- Maydn Fleury recorded his first goal of the season and his third assist, marking his fifth career multi-point game and first since October 28, 2021 with Seattle (2-0—2 vs. MIN).
- Nick Paul picked up a goal and two assists to record his 14th, 15th and 16th points of the season...Paul tallied his fourth multi-point game of the season and the 22nd of his career....Paul registered just the fourth three-point game of his career.
- Steven Stamkos notched three assists to record his 32nd, 33rd and 34th points of the season (15-18—33)...Stamkos registered the 295th multi-point game of his NHL career and passed Theo Fleury (294) for sole possession of 57th place on the League's all-time list...Stamkos took three shots on goal to pass Vincent Lecavalier for sole possession of the most shots on goal in Lightning history...Stamkos has collected eight points over his last seven games vs. STL (1-7—8) and has 15 points over his 11 career home contests against the Blues (4-11-15)...Stamkos (7-12-19, 20 GP) passed Martin St. Louis (4-13-17, 15 GP) for sole possession of the most points by a Lightning skater against the Blues.
- Brayden Point (14-21—35), Brandon Hagel (10-18—28), Nick Perbix (0-7—7), Conor Sheary (1-5—6), Victor Hedman (5-24—29) and **Tanner Jeannot** (6-6—12) each recorded one assist.
- Brandon Hagel has tallied four points over his last four games against the Blues (1-3—4).
- Victor Hedman has eight points over his last eight home games against the Blues (2-6—8).
- Nick Perbix skated in his 100th career NHL game.
