## **TEAM NOTES**

- This is the second of three contests against Detroit this season and the Flyers will split the series with one win each with the Red Wings.
- Philadelphia holds a 3-2-1 record in the first game of a back-to-back series and a 1-4-0 record in the second contest.
- Philadelphia has a 7-8-2 record against the Eastern Conference, including a 5-4-2 record against the Atlantic Division.
- **Travis Konecny** scored the first goal for Philadelphia, his 12th goal this season. He has seven points (3g-4a) in the last six games and 14 points (5g-9a) in the last 12 games. He ranks tied for sixth in the NHL in points (27) since Nov. 5th.
- Joel Farabee tallied an assist on the Konecny goal, his eighth assist his season, and has four points (1g-3a) in the last seven games. He ranks tied for sixth on the team in assists.
- Sean Couturier posted his 3rd multi-assist game (Og-2a) of the season and owns eight points (3g-5a) in the last 12 games. With his 317th career assist on Konecny's goal, he takes sole possession of 12th in Flyers history in all-time assists.
- **Noah Cates** scored his third goal of the season and now has three points (2g-1a) in the last four games. He owns five points (3g-2a) in the last six games against the Red Wings.
- **Tyson Foerster** notched the primary assist on the Cates goal, his fifth assist this season. He has five points (3g-2a) in the last nine games and seven points (4g-3a) in the last 14 games.
- Nick Seeler recorded a secondary assist on Cates' goal, his ninth assist of the season, and owns five points (1g-4a) in the last seven games. He ranks T-14th in the NHL in blocked shots (71).
- **Ryan Poehling** scored the third goal for Flyers, his second of the season, to break an 11-game goal drought. He has two points (1g-1a) in the last two games.
- **Travis Sanheim** tallied his 14th assist of the season on Poehling's goal to extend his point streak to three games (1g-2a). He has five points (1g-4a) in the last six games and ranks tied for eighth among NHL defensemen in points (14) since Nov. 11th.
- **Owen Tippett** scored his 10th goal of the season and has six points (6g-0a) in the last eight games. He ranks second on the team in shots (82), third in goals (10) and fourth in points (17).
- Scott Laughton posted an assist on Tippett's goal, his eighth assist this season, and owns six points (4g-2a) in the last seven games. He has 17 points (12g-5a) in the last 12 games against the Red Wings.

• Jamie Drysdale notched his fourth assist of the season on the Tippett goal and has two assists in the last four games.
