

## IOWA WILD REPORT – JANUARY 3, 2023

lowa went 0-2-0 in its two-games against Colorado last week. The two teams opened up their two-game set on Thursday, Dec. 28 with lowa falling, 4-2. **Caedan Banker** scored lowa's only two goals in the first period, one of which was a power-play goal. **Zane McIntyre** stopped 32-of-36 shots faced in the opening game. The two teams closed out the series on Saturday, Jan 30 with lowa falling, 6-2. **Carson Lambos** and **Nic Petan** were the goal scorers for lowa, and Petan registered an assist for two points on the night. **Hunter Jones** made 48 saves on 54 shots in his first game with lowa this season—his 48 saves were the most for lowa since 2018. Through 30 games, lowa is 12-16-2 and 13 points behind Texas for first place in the Central Division. Petan (10-18=28) leads all lowa skaters with 28 points. **Jake Lucchini** has 20 points (9-11=20) and **Jujhar Khaira** owns 19 points (5-14=19). **Jesper Wallstedt** is 11-7-0 with a 2.43 GAA, a .922 SV% and two shutouts. He ranks T-4th in the AHL in SV%, T-5th in shutouts and sixth in wins. McIntyre is 1-8-2 with a 3.54 GAA and a .884 SV%. Iowa will host the Grand Rapids Griffins for two games beginning on Friday, Jan. 5 at 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, Jan 6 at 6:00 p.m.
