HOME SWEET HOME

- The Flyers play their final two 2023-24 regular season home contests Saturday vs. NJD and Tuesday vs. WSH.
- Philadelphia is 19-16-4 for 42 home points in 39 games this season. The Flyers look to reach 20-plus home wins in a single season for the seventh time in the last 11 seasons (2013-24) and for the first time since 2019-20 (25).
- The Flyers set a season-high three-game home win streak three times from Oct. 17-26, Dec. 4-16 and Feb. 8-12. The Flyers also set a season-high four-game home point streak twice from Nov. 30-Dec. 16 (3-0-1) and from Feb. 27-March 12 (3-0-1).
- Philadelphia has scored four-plus goals in 13 of its 39 home games this season (including shootout game-deciding goals), posting a 11-2-0 record when scoring four-plus goals.

MISCELLANEOUS STATS

- Philadelphia ranks second in the NHL with 2,659 shots and T-3rd with a 33.2 shot-per-game average.
- The Flyers lead the NHL with 17 40-plus shot games this season - their third-most 40-plus shot contests in a season in franchise history. The last time the Flyers registered 17-or-more games with 40-plus shots in a season was 1983-84 (29). The Flyers tallied a season-high 48 shots in the 2024 NHL Stadium Series, Feb. 17 at NJD.
- Philadelphia established an NHL single-season record for most penalty shot goals with five on March 2 vs. OTT. The Flyers bested the 2013-14 Dallas Stars, 2005-06 Carolina Hurricanes, 2003-04 Minnesota Wild and 1997-98 Vancouver Canucks who all had four.
- The Flyers lead the League with 1,485 blocked shots and defenseman **Nick Seeler** ranks fifth in the NHL with a career-high 198 blocked shots.
- Philadelphia ranks seventh in the NHL with 1,954 hits and forward **Garnet Hathaway** ranks second in the League with 318 hits.

PENALTY KILLERS

- Philadelphia leads the NHL with 15 shorthanded goals, ranks fourth with an 83.3 penalty kill percentage and ranks fifth in fewest power-play goals against (PPGA) with 40. The Flyers' franchise record for highest PK percentage in a season is 86.7 done twice (1999-00, 1997-98).
- The Flyers rank third in the NHL with an 87.0 home penalty kill percentage. Philadelphia set a franchise record for home penalty kill percentage with 91.2 in 1997-98.
- Philadelphia last recorded 15-plus SHG during the 2008-09 season with 16.

OPEN THE CATES

- **Noah Cates** scored his sixth goal of the season Thursday at NYR to extend his point streak to a career-high five games (3-2=5).
- He missed 22 games this season due to a lower-body injury from Nov. 28-Jan. 13.
- The Minnesota native skated in his 100th NHL game on Oct. 14 at OTT and tied his career-high 11 faceoff wins on Nov. 1 vs. BUF.



KONNECT FOUR

- **Travis Konecny** sits one point shy of 400 career NHL points, all with PHI. He can become the 21st player in team history to reach the 400-point plateau.
- He registered two points (1-1=2) Thursday for his 20th multi-point game this season. He owns nine points (5-4=9) in the last 11 games.
- He owns 25 points (10-15=25) in his last 24 games, including a tied for season-high seven-game point streak (5-7=12) from Feb. 6-21.
- He leads the Flyers in goals (32), SHG (5), assists (35) and points (67), ranks T-1st in GWG (4) and first goals of the game (6), second in shots (238) and fifth in PIM (67) while ranking T-1st in the NHL in SHG.
- He tallied a career-high seven hits, April 9 at MTL.
- The winger was named an alternate captain Feb. 14 - the first of his career to don the "A."
- He represented the Flyers at the 2024 NHL All-Star Weekend, Feb. 1-3, in Toronto - his second career NHL All-Star appearance.
- The forward registered a season-high three-game goal streak (4g) from Jan. 2-6 and a season-high seven-game point streak (5-5=10) from Dec. 22-Jan. 6.
- He collected 15 points in a career-high 10-game road point streak (6-9=15) from Dec. 7-Jan. 12. Per NHL Stats, he became the first Flyers player to post a double-digit road point streak since Jeremy Roenick (12 GP, 2001-02).
- The winger recorded his first career penalty shot goal Dec. 9 at COL.
- The London, Ontario native has seven multi-goal contests and 20 multi-point games in 74 games this season.
- He skated in his 500th career NHL game Nov. 4 vs. LAK to become the 40th player in team history to reach the milestone.

LOCKED ON LAUGHTON

- **Scott Laughton** is expected to skate in his 600th career NHL game Saturday to become the 22nd player in franchise history to reach the 600-game plateau.
- He leads the Flyers and ranks T-1st in the NHL in shorthanded points (7).
- The forward set a career-high six-game assist streak (6a) from Feb. 12-25 and a career-high seven-game point streak (4-6=10) from Feb. 10-25.
- He registered three points (2-1=3) including a shorthanded goal and a career-high plus-4 rating Feb. 25 at PIT. The three-point contest was his first of the season and his fourth career.
- He scored his first career penalty shot goal on Jan. 18 vs. DAL.
- He tallied his first shorthanded point (assist) of the season on Oct. 21 at DAL.
- He collected two assists Oct. 12 at CBJ for his first multi-point game of the season, including his 200th career NHL point.

TIPP OF THE HAT

- **Owen Tippett** has 15 points (6-9=15) in the last 15 games.
- He owns 31 points (16-15=31) in his last 37 games - he missed four games due to a lower-body injury (Jan. 21-27).
- The Ontario native leads the team in shots (283), ranks T-1st in GWG (4) and second in goals (28) and points (53).
- He set a career-high six-game point streak (3-6=9) from March 12-23 and a career-high four-game assist streak (6a) from March 16-23.
- He set a career-high three assists March 16 at BOS for his second career three-point game.
- He registered a career-high nine hits March 7 at FLA.
- He netted two goals Feb. 17 against the Devils during the 2024 Navy Credit Federal Union Stadium Series game at MetLife Stadium to mark his second multi-goal performance of the season (last, Jan. 18 vs. DAL). He became the first Flyer to record multiple goals in an NHL outdoor game.
- He has tallied a career-high 10 shots twice this season: Jan. 15 at STL; Feb. 17 at NJD.
- He signed an eight-year \$49.6 million contract extension (\$6.2 million AAV) on Jan. 26.
- Has matched his career-high four-game goal streak, Nov. 10-18.
- The right-shot forward recorded his 100th career NHL point (goal) on Nov. 15 at CAR.
- He skated in his 200th career NHL game Oct. 28 vs. ANA and in his 100th career game as a Flyer on Oct. 14 at OTT.

FROSTING OVER

- **Morgan Frost** owns 10 points (4-6=10) in the last 15 games.
- He owns 14 points (4-10=14) in the last 21 games, including four multi-point contests.
- He set a career-high six-game point streak (3-5=8) from March 12-23.
- He netted his first career penalty shot goal Feb. 12 vs. ARI.
- The Ontario native skated in his 200th NHL game Feb. 10 vs. SEA.
- His second assist on Jan. 20 vs. COL marked his 20th point of the season to reach 20-plus points for his second consecutive season.
- The forward leads the team with a career-high 11 PPP and ranks T-4th with a career-high three PPG.
