NOTES:

TREVOR CARRICK ranks tied for third among league defensemen in points (2-9=11) and assists, while leading the Gulls in both categories. With his assists Nov. 11 vs. Colorado and Nov. 15 vs. Charlotte, he is currently riding a two-game point/assist streak.

OLEN ZELLWEGER currently ranks second among rookie defensemen in points (2-6=8) and ranks tied for second in goals and assists. Zellweger recorded a career-high three assists (0-3=3) Nov. 10 vs. Calgary.

PAVOL REGENDA ranks tied for third in the league in goals (8) and leads San Diego in goals and ranks second in points (8-2=10).

ANDREW AGOZZINO recorded a five-game point-streak Oct. 29-Nov. 10 and ranks third among Gulls leaders in points (1-8=9), second in assists and second with a +4 rating.

BEN KING ranks tied for third among Gulls leaders in goals (3), ranks fourth in assists (5) and tied for fifth in scoring (3-5=8), tallying 2-4=6 points in his last six games.

JOSH LOPINA tallied a career-high three goals through his first 12 games of the season, while **NATHAN GAUCHER** recorded his first career AHL goal Nov. 10 vs. Calgary.

CALLE CLANG stopped 10-of-11 shots in his sixth appearance of the season Nov. 10 vs. Calgary, after entering the game to start the third period. Clang also made 26 saves Nov. 11 vs. Colorado and 27 saves Nov. 15 vs. Charlotte.

CAREY TERRANCE ranks tied for seventh in the league in goal scoring (13) and is tied for second in the OHL in short handed goals (2) while he leads Erie with 13-10=23 points and goals.

RODWIN DIONICIO ranks fourth among OHL defensemen in points (5-15=20) while he ranks tied for second among Saginaw skaters in scoring and second in assists. Dionicio has 2-13=15 points through his last nine games.
