

EYEING CAREER HIGHS

Bryan Rust and Rickard Rakell enter tonight's game each one goal away from tying their previous career-high goal totals.

- Rakell, who has scored a team-leading 33 goals in 75 games this season, tied his second-highest single-season goal total of his career with a tally in St. Louis on Thursday:
- Rakell also enters tonight's game three points away from tying his careerhigh point total of 69 set during the 2017-18 season with Anaheim:

Sidney Crosby enters tonight's game on a hot streak, recording points in 11-consecutive games dating back to March 9.

Rutger McGroarty scored his first NHL goal at 19:35 of the third period on Sunday to force overtime. His goal with 25 seconds remaining in regulation was the 12th-latest first NHL goal in League history.



Rutger McGroarty became the seventh-youngest player since 2005-06 to record a multi-point game when he recorded a goal and assist on Thursday in St. Louis at 21 years and 4 days old.



Erik Karlsson enters tonight's game one goal away from becoming the 24th defenseman in NHL history, and second active, to score 200 career goals.



Sidney Crosby, who is riding an 11-game point streak, enters tonight's game one game shy of tying the longest point streak by a player age 37 or older in NHL history.



Ville Koivunen recorded his first NHL point on Rutger McGroarty's first NHL goal on Thursday in St. Louis. He skated in 17:47 minutes in his second career NHL game.
