AT A GLANCE

SWISS-SATIONAL

Forward Kevin Fiala returns home to Crypto.com Arena as the third Kings skater to reach the 60-point (35-25=60) threshold this season, joining Adrian Kempe (35-38=73) and Anze Kopitar (21-46=67). On Tuesday night in Seattle, Fiala (0-2=2) notched his 24th assist of the campaign for his 25th power play point of the year (14-11=25), the most among all Kings skaters. In the second period, the Swiss forward added his 25th helper of the year to register his fourth consecutive multi-point game (5-3=8), dating back to April 10 against Anaheim. Fiala's recent stretch of performances is the first four-game multi-point streak by a Kings skater this season and the 29th such streak recorded in the NHL this season.


DR. DREI

After picking up his 26th assist of the season on Tuesday against the Kraken, forward **Andrei Kuzmenko** returns to Crypto.com Arena with 15 points (5-10=15) in the 14 contests played in the building since the trade deadline, tied with linemate Anze Kopitar (6-9=15) and trails only Quinton Byfield (9-7=16) for the most home points among Kings skaters since joining the team. In his lone contest against tonight's opponent this season, Kuzmenko scored a goal and added an assist against his former team on March 4 during his seven-game stint with the Philadelphia Flyers.

AWAY TEAM'S CRYPTO-NITE

After sweeping their two-game road set earlier this week, the Kings return to Los Angeles for the first time since capping off their four-game homestand with a 5-4 victory over the Colorado Avalanche this past Saturday afternoon. That victory secured the team's 31st win at Crypto.com Arena this season and improved their overall home record to 31-5-4. The 2024-25 season marks the first time in franchise history the team has reached the 30-home win mark. Since the Trade Deadline on March 7, the Kings are 17-4-0 with a points percentage (PTS %) of .810%, pacing all NHL teams in the span. The Kings also lead the NHL in goals-for (80 GF) and goals-against (39 GA) in that timeframe.




