SAN DIEGO earned standing points in seven of 13 games in the month of December going 6-5-1.

OLEN ZELLWEGER was named to the 2024 AHL All-Star Classic to be held February 4-5 in San Jose, Calif., becoming the fourth Gulls rookie to be named an All-Star in franchise history. Zellweger leads AHL rookie blueliners in PPG (3) and ranks second in points (6-16=22), goals, assists and shots (88). He also ranks second among San Diego skaters in assists and third in points.

TREVOR CARRICK ranks tied for eighth among league defensemen in points (5-18=23) . Carrick co-leads the Gulls in assists and ranks second in points..

ANDREW AGOZZINO leads the Gulls in points (8-18=26) and co-leads in assists. Agozzino tallied 1-2=3 points Jan. 10 vs. Coachella Valley for his third three-point effort and seventh multi-point game of the season.

CHASE DE LEO is averaging a point per game through 13 GP this season (5-8=13) and has 1-1=2 points in as many games to start the new year.

JOSH LOPINA ranks tied for third among Gulls leaders in goal scoring (8-6=14) and recorded a career-high three-game point streak (3-2=5) Dec. 28-Jan. 3 (3-2=5) .

BRAYDEN TRACEY has recorded 5-3=8 points through his last nine games, ranking tied for fourth among San Diego leaders in goal scoring.

CALLE CLANG stopped 26 shots to earn his fourth win on the season, Dec. 28 vs. Ontario, improving to 4-7-3 with a 3.44 GAA and .888 SV %.

TOMAS SUCHANEK stopped 34 shots to earn his fifth win and improve to 5-2=1 with a 2.13 GAA and .932 SV% this season.

YEGOR SIDOROV co-leads the WHL in GWG (8), ranks second in goals (34), third in PPG (11) and tied for 12th in points (34-19=53). He leads Saskatoon in goals, PPG and GWG while ranking second on the team in scoring and tied for fourth in assists. Sidorov is currently averaging 1.43 points per game and recorded his second season-high 10 game point streak (10-19=19) Dec. 1-Jan. 5.

RODWIN DIONICIO tallied 2-2=4 points in five games for Team Switzerland at the 2024 World Junior Championship. He currently ranks tied for fifth among OHL defensemen in goals (11) and tied for 11th in points (11-19=30). He also ranks tied for second among Saginaw blueliners in points and second in goals.

CAREY TERRANCE ranks tied for second among OHL leaders in SHG (4) and tied for eighth in goal scoring (22). He also leads the Erie Otters in goals and SHG, while ranking third in points (22-12=34). Terrance is currently riding a three-game point/goal streak (4-0=4) and has 9-2=11 points through his last nine games.

NOAH WARREN represented Team Canada at the 2024 World Junior Championship, posting a +1 rating in 5 games. Warren has tallied 2-3=5 points through 21 games with Victoriaville of the QMJHL this season and ranks third among team blueliners with a +9.

CONNOR HVIDSTON ranks third among Swift Current leaders in goals (17), sixth in points (17-17=34) and is averaging 1.26 points per game. He is currently riding a four game point streak (3-3=6) and has 5-9=14 points through his last nine games.

CUTTER GAUTHIER led the Americans to a gold medal at the 2024 World Junior Championship, co-leading the tournament in points (2-10=12) and assists while serving as an alternate captain. He was named the Best Forward and to the 2024 tournament All-Star Team, leading Team USA in points and assists while scoring the game-winning goal in the third period of the Semifinal to help the U.S. advance to the gold medal game. Gauthier has scored 13-10=23 points with a +6 rating in 17 games with Boston College (Hockey East) this season to lead the Eagles in goals and rank sixth among all NCAA leaders in goals.

SAM COLANGELO ranks second among Western Michigan leaders in goals (13) and PPG (5) while ranking third in points (13-8=21). He is currently riding a five-game point streak (6-3=9).

WILL FRANCIS appeared in his first game with Minnesota-Duluth, an exhibition game at St. Thomas, since missing the beginning of the season due to his second battle with acute lymphoblastic leukemia. Francis announced he is cancer free and will be redshirting for the remainder of the season.
