AT A GLANCE

HOW SWEDE IT IS

Forward **Adrian Kempe** returns to Enterprise Center with a pair of points (1-1=2) in the building already this year, following his heroics in the Kings' 2-1 overtime victory on Oct. 21, 2025. That game saw the 29-year-old winger pick up his sixth assist of the season before scoring the Kings' first overtime goal of the campaign, the eighth of his now 10 extra-time tallies in his career. That effort was part of his career-long seven-game road point streak (5-6=11) from Oct. 11 – 28, 2025, which included two overtime goals in consecutive games on Oct. 21 in St. Louis and Oct. 23 in Dallas to make the native of Kramfors, Sweden, the first player in franchise history to net the game-winner in overtime in consecutive games. Kempe now returns to the road after closing the Kings' January home slate this past Tuesday night by scoring his 17th goal of the season just 18 seconds into the game against the Rangers, marking the Kings' fastest goal from the start of a game since **Warren Foegele** (0:11 on Feb. 7, 2025). Kempe's strike at Crypto.com Arena marked the 11th-fastest goal from the start of a regular season game in franchise history; the list is topped by **Tiger Williams**, who scored seven seconds into a matchup with the Hartford Whalers on Feb. 14, 1987.

CAN'T CATCH 22

Forward **Kevin Fiala** skated in the 700th regular season contest of his career on Tuesday against the New York Rangers, becoming the 41st player in franchise history to play his 700th career game in a Kings uniform. In that contest, Fiala scored his 18th goal of the season and picked up his 18th assist for his sixth multi-point effort (1-1=2) of the campaign. In doing so, he tied defenseman **Brandt Clarke** for third on the team this season in both multi-point games (6 GP) and assists (18 A). The native of St. Gallen, Switzerland, is the ninth skater in Kings history to score a goal in his 700th game and joins **Roman Josi** (1-1=2 on Nov. 26, 2021) as the only two Swiss-born players in NHL history to record a multi-point effort in their 700th career game. Fiala now has five points (2-3=5) in his last four appearances, dating back to his fifth multi-point game (1-1=2) of the season on Wednesday, Jan. 14, versus Vegas. Since Fiala joined the organization ahead of the 2022-23 season, only **Adrian Kempe** (69 GP) has recorded more multi-point performances for the LA Kings than the Swiss winger's 67 such efforts.
