TOP NOTES

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen's shutout sequence ended at 164:09 after Tampa Bay's first goal of the game. It was officially the eighth-longest shutout sequence in Sabres history. It was the longest since Martin Biron did not allow a goal in 221:58 from Jan. 11 to 25, 2003, which was the longest in Sabres history.

Dylan Cozens' goal was his eighth of the season and his third against Tampa Bay in his career. In his last three games against the Lightning, he has registered three points (2+1), recording one point in each of those games.

Rasmus Dahlin recorded an assist on **Cozens'** goal and has now tallied eight points (3+5) in his last eight games. He has notched six assists in his last five games against the Lightning, including at least one assist in each game in that span.

Dahlin's assist made him the 14th defenseman to ever record an assist streak of five or more games against the Lightning, and the first to do so with the Sabres.

JJ Peterka's primary assist on **Cozens'** goal gave him one point in consecutive games (1+1). It marked the seventh time this season that he had recorded a point in at least two consecutive games.
