



VEGAS GOLDEN KNIGHTS READING WEEK 2026 OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THE VEGAS GOLDEN KNIGHTS READING WEEK 2026 PROMOTION (the “Promotion”). A purchase will not increase your chances of winning.

By entering into the Promotion, each participant unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these official rules (“Official Rules”) and the decisions of Howard Hughes Properties, Inc. (“Sponsor” or “SPONSOR”) and Black Knight Sports and Entertainment LLC d/b/a Vegas Golden Knights (“BKSE”) which shall be final and binding in all matters relating to this Promotion.

The Promotion will begin at 10:00 AM PST on February 2, 2026, and will end at 5:00 PM PST on February 13, 2026 (“Promotion Period”). SPONSOR’S servers and clock shall serve as the official clock for the Promotion and participants’ proof of submission does not constitute proof of receipt by SPONSOR.

1. Eligibility. To be eligible to compete in the Promotion, participant must be an employee/teacher of a PreK – 5th grade school or class with a school mailing address located in the Clark County School District during the Promotion Period. Any attempt by any person to submit more than one entry will void all of that person’s entries and that person will be disqualified. Employees, officers, and directors (including immediate family members (spouse, parent, child and sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and members of the same household, whether or not related) of SPONSOR, BKSE, National Hockey League (“NHL”), other NHL teams (“NHL Entities”), and each of their respective parents, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, licensees, distributors, dealers, retailers, printers and advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the Promotion, (collectively, “SPONSOR Entities”) are not eligible to enter or win. If a participant is unable to participate in the Promotion as requested by the SPONSOR, SPONSOR and/or BKSE reserve the right to deem that participant’s entry is forfeited in its entirety and that participant will be disqualified. The Promotion is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations.

2. How to Enter. To enter the Promotion each participant must complete a nomination form, found on the Vegas Golden Knights website under the Community tab or at readingweek@vegasknightknights.com.

All entries must comply with the entry criteria set forth herein, be fully completed and received by the conclusion of the Promotion Period. All entries must comply with these Official Rules. LIMIT ONE ENTRY PER PERSON. No other method of entry is acceptable. In the event of a dispute as to the identity or eligibility of a winner based on an e-mail address, the winning entry will be declared made by the “Authorized Account Holder” of the e-mail address submitted at the time of entry, provided he/she is eligible according to these Official Rules. The “Authorized Account Holder” is defined as the natural person to whom the applicable Internet service provider or other organization (such as a business or educational institution) has assigned the e-mail address for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address.

Any attempt by any participant to obtain more than one entry by using multiple/different email addresses, identities, or any other methods will void that participant’s entry and that participant may be disqualified. Entries will become the property of SPONSOR and will not be returned or acknowledged.

- Entries must be the participant’s sole, original work.

- Entries must conform to BKSE's standards and practices, and may not be offensive, as determined by BKSE in its sole discretion. Entries may not disparage Sponsor, BKSE, their parent, subsidiaries or affiliates or any of their respective teams, products or services.
- Entries may not defame or invade the publicity, privacy or intellectual property rights of any person living or deceased, or otherwise infringe upon any person's rights
- Entries must be in good taste and appropriate for a family audience (as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion) and may not contain nudity, obscenity, profanity, indecent material, lewd acts, references to violence, or demean any gender, race, religion or sexual orientation.
- Entries may not contain third-party materials (other than those of Sponsor), or otherwise violate or infringe (or may infringe) any copyright, trademark, logo, mark that identifies a brand or other proprietary right of any person living or deceased (including but not limited to rights of privacy or publicity or portrayal in a false light) or entity.

3. SPONSOR'S Use of Entries and Related Materials. By entering, participants grant Sponsor, BKSE, the other NHL Entities and each of their respective designees the irrevocable right and permission to use, separately or together, their name, voice, statements, photograph, likeness, recorded performance and/or biographical information, in whole or in part, on the internet and in all media now known or hereinafter developed, in perpetuity throughout the world, for all purposes, including advertising and promotional purposes, without restriction as to alteration. By submitting an entry, each participant grants a perpetual, royalty-free and worldwide license to Sponsor and BKSE of all intellectual property rights in all entry materials and all other related materials provided to SPONSOR or otherwise prepared in connection with the Promotion (collectively, "Entry Materials"), which may or may not include the participant's name, voice, image, photograph, likeness, city and state of residence. Pursuant to the license granted herein, participants agree that Sponsor and BKSE shall have the right to use, edit, adapt, modify, reproduce, promote, display, distribute, perform, assign and otherwise use Entry Materials in any way they see fit without compensation to participants. Participants also agree that the rights granted to Sponsor in these Official Rules are without compensation or attribution of any kind. Each participant agrees to take, at SPONSOR'S expense, any further action (including without limitation, execution of affidavits and other documents) reasonably requested by SPONSOR and/or BKSE to effect, perfect or confirm SPONSOR's and BKSE's rights as set forth in this Paragraph 3.

4. Winner Selection. During the week of February 16, 2026, twenty (20) potential winners will be selected by SPONSOR based on the originality and creativity of their response on why their class or school deserves a reading week visit.

5. Winner Notification. Each potential winner will be notified by SPONSOR via email using the email address provided at time of entry during the week of February 16, 2026. SPONSOR will make three (3) attempts to contact the potential winner by the method described above within three (3) business days after they were determined to be the potential winner. If SPONSOR is unable to reach the winner by the method described above within five (5) days of SPONSOR'S first notification, that potential winner will be disqualified and an alternate potential winner will be determined from all remaining eligible entries based upon the criteria described in these Official Rules.

All potential winners are subject to verification by Sponsor, whose decisions are final and binding. Potential winners may be required to complete, except where prohibited, an Affidavit of Eligibility/Liability/Publicity Release and may also be required to submit completed liability and publicity releases for individuals participating in the Prize (the "Winner Documents"). If requested, Winner Documents must be completed and returned by the date and time indicated or the potential winner will forfeit the Prize and an alternative potential winner will be determined from the remaining eligible entries based upon the criteria described in these Official Rules. No more than the stated number of Prizes will be awarded. In the event that production, technical, seeding, programming, or any other reasons cause more than the stated number of Prizes as set forth in these Official Rules to be available and/or claimed, Sponsor reserves the right to award only the stated number of Prizes by a random drawing among all legitimate, un-awarded, eligible Prize claims.

7. Limitation of Liability; No Warranties and Release.
