MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has earned points in six of the last nine meetings between the clubs since Jan. 22, 2020 (5-3-1).
- ★ CBJ have also earned points in three of the last four games played at Winnipeg (2-1-1).
- ★ The winning team has recorded four or more goals in 14 of the last 17 games of the series dating back to Dec. 10, 2015 and has limited the other team to one goal or less in six of the last eight since Nov. 24, 2021.
- ★ The winning team has also recorded four-plus goals in 11-straight meetings at Winnipeg (CBJ; 5-5-1).
- ★ The Jackets finished 1-for-2 on the power play in each game of the 2024-25 series and are 10-for-29 in the last nine games at Canada Life Centre (34.5 pct.).
- Columbus has recorded five of the seven shutouts in the all-time series (MR CBJ: Merzlikins, 36 saves in 3-0 W at CBJ on Nov. 24,2021) but Winnipeg recorded the most recent one (Hellebuyck, 29 saves in 5-0 win at WPG on Jan. 9, 2024).



JACKET TO WATCH C Sean Monahan

Has 7-14-21 in 32 career GP vs. Winnipeg. Collected points in both games of 2024-25 series (1-1-2) and has points in 5 of his last 7 contests against the team (3-2-5).





JET TO WATCH - G Connor Hellebuyck

Three-Time Vezina Trophy winner is 6-1-0 with a 1.94 GAA and .939 SV% in 7 career GP vs. CBJ. Is 4-0-0 with a 2.20 GAA and .926 SV% in 4 career home games against the club.



TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets have registered points in five-straight games overall (3-0-2) and at home (4-0-1) following a 4-3 SO win over Montreal on Monday.
- ★ The Jackets played in their sixth consecutive one-goal game since Nov. 8 (3-1-2) and for the 10th time in the last 12 contests (6-2-2) against the Canadiens.
- * Columbus has scored a power play goal in two-straight contests (2-for-4; 50.0 pct.) and in three of the last four games since Nov. 11 (3-for-9: 33.3 pct.).
- * CBJ play their lone game against the Western Conference over a 14-game stretch from Nov. 15-Dec. 11 tonight vs. Winnipeg.
- ★ The Jackets close out their fifth back-to-back set of the campaign tonight against the Jets. The club leads the NHL in wins in back-to-back games in 2025-26 with a 6-2-1 record (3-1-0 in second game).
- * The club, which is in a stretch of nine-of-12 games played on the road from Nov. 2-24, begin a four-game road trip at Winnipeg.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C Charlie Coyle, who has 2-2-4 in last three contests, sits two points from 500 for his NHL career (192-306-498, 969 GP).
- ★ C Adam Fantilli has notched goals in four of the past five games and points in six of the last seven (4-3-7).
- ★ RW Kirill Marchenko extended his career-high assists streak to six games (2-7-9) and points streak to 12 games (3-12-15) with two assists on Monday. It's tied with RW Cam Atkinson (12 GP in 2018-19) for the second-longest points streak in club history, trailing only C Ryan Johansen's 13-game streak in 2014-15.
- ★ LW **Dmitri Voronkov** collected his fourth multi-point outing of the campaign with 1-1-2 vs. Montreal. He has notched power play goals in consecutive games and has 3-3-6 in the past six contests.
- ★ D Zach Werenski, who has assists in three-straight outings (1-3-4) and four of the past five (1-4-5), notched his team-leading fifth multi-point effort of the campaign on Monday (1-1-2). He is one point shy of becoming the first defenseman and third player to register 400 points with the club (118-281-399, 586 GP).
