- · On Apr. 15, 2006, Jonathan Cheechoo recorded his fifth hat trick of the 2005-06 season, his third against Anaheim, as the Sharks defeated the Ducks, 6-3.
- · On Mar. 28, 2008, the San Jose Sharks defeated the Ducks, 3-1, to capture the 2007-08 Pacific Division Championship. Joe Pavelski helped set up all three Sharks goals.
- · On Dec. 26, 2009, Patrick Marleau scored his 300th and 301st NHL goals in a 5-2 win.
- · On Nov. 30, 2013, San Jose defeated Anaheim 4-3 in the shootout to cap off a 5-0-0 homestand, the Sharks' first perfect five-game homestand in franchise history.
- · On Jan. 29, 2015, Joe Thornton surpassed Phil Housley to claim sole possession of 37th place on the NHL's All-Time Points List with two assists while the Sharks received six goals from six different players en route to a 6-3 victory against the Anaheim Ducks.
- · On Oct. 10, 2015, Patrick Marleau scored two goals and moved into 55th place on the all-time NHL goal list while Martin Jones recorded his first shutout as a Shark in a 2-0 win over Anaheim in the home opener.
- · On Oct. 18, 2018, Brent Burns and Timo Meier became the third pair of teammates in franchise history to register simultaneous eight game point streaks, last achieved by Joe Thornton (8 games, 2g, 14a) and Ryane Clowe (8 games, 4g, 5a) in 2009-10.
- · On Dec. 27, 2018, Brent Burns appeared in his 1,000th career NHL game and scored the game-winning goal to become the third defenseman in NHL history to score the game-winning goal in his 1,000th career game.
- · On Feb. 15, 2021, Sharks head coach Bob Boughner won his 100th game as a NHL head coach
- · On Apr. 6, 2021, Patrick Marleau scored a goal to pass Mats Sundin and Joe Nieuwendyk for 23rd on the NHL's all-time games played list
- · On Mar. 26, 2022, Timo Meier recorded the third hat trick of his career in a 4-1 Sharks win over Anaheim.
- · On Nov. 1, 2022, Erik Karlsson scored his first career hat trick in a 5-6 Sharks shootout loss to Anaheim. This marked the first hat trick by a player playing as a defenseman in franchise history (Brent Burns recorded one playing as a forward on Nov. 29, 2013 at St. Louis).
- On Dec. 9, 2022, rookie Eetu Mäkiniemi earned his first NHL win in his first career start after saving 23 shots. In the process, Makiniemi became the youngest-ever Sharks goalie (23 years, 234 days) to win their first-career NHL start (previously Miikka Kiprusoff, 24 years, 164 days). Kevin Labanc recorded his 200th NHL point with an assist in the contest.
- · On Nov. 12, 2023, Marc-Edouard Vlasic played in his 1,251st career game, tying him with Jari Kurri for 100th-most games played in NHL history, and logged two hits in 10:04 time on ice.
- · On Jan. 31, 2024, Shakir Mukhamadullin collected his first NHL point (assist).
- On Oct. 22, 2024, Jack Thompson collected his first NHL point (assist).

- On Jan. 10, 2006, the Sharks defeated the Bruins in Boston for the first time in franchise history. It was Joe Thornton's first game against his former team following the Nov. 30, 2005 trade to San Jose. Thornton was ejected at 5:13 of the first period for cross-checking Hal Gill.
- On Feb. 10, 2009, Joe Thornton scored his first goal against Boston in his second game since being traded from the Bruins in 2005.
- · On Jan. 11, 2014, Finnish Olympic teammates Antti Niemi (SJS) and Tuukka Rask (BOS) turned in goaltending gems in a 1-0 Boston victory. The Sharks were held without a goal for only the second time on the season. Niemi made 21 saves, and Tommy Wingels had 10 hits during the game.
- · On Dec. 4, 2014, the Sharks got two goals apiece from three different players, scoring seven goals in total, to win 7-4 and set a new franchise record for goals against the Boston Bruins.
- · On Mar. 15, 2016, Joonas Donskoi scored the game-winning goal on the power play and Brent Burns tied Sandis Ozolinsh for most goals (26) and points (64) in a season by a Sharks defenseman in a 3-2 victory.
- On Feb. 9, 2017, Joe Thornton recorded his 1375th career NHL point, passing Mike Modano for sole possession of 23rd place all-time.
- · On Oct 26, 2017, Joe Thornton scored a goal against his former team to tie Jari Kurri for 20th all-time in NHL career points (1398).
- · On Feb. 18, 2019, Logan Couture scored a shorthanded penalty-shot goal, the fourth player to do so in franchise history.

- · On Nov. 5, 1992, Larry DePalma and Dave Snuggerud each scored a goal seven seconds apart, setting a franchise record for the fastest two goals in a 7-5 win.
- On Dec. 2, 2005, Joe Thornton made his debut for San Jose, tallying two assists. Evgeni Nabokov and Nolan Schaefer shared a shutout, the first shutout ever between the two teams. The Sharks pulled out a 5-0 victory, their first ever win in Buffalo.
- · On Nov. 5, 2013, San Jose broke a franchise record for most 50+ shot games in a single season (four) but fell 5-4 to Buffalo in the shootout.
- On Nov. 14, 2015, Joe Pavelski recorded his 500th point, Patrick Marleau scored the game-winning goal in overtime and the Sharks earned a 2-1 victory, their first win Buffalo since 2005.
- On Feb. 7, 2017, 11 different Sharks had points as San Jose held a 4-1 lead into the third period, but helped by Evander Kane's two goals, Buffalo forced overtime and won 5-4.
- On Oct. 18, 2018, Logan Couture led the offensive charge against Buffalo with three goals for his third career hat trick. In the same contest, Marc-Edouard Vlasic skated in his 900th NHL game and became the first San Jose Sharks defenseman to appear in 900 career games with the franchise.
- On Nov. 23, 2024, the Sharks retired Joe Thornton's No. 19 in a pregame ceremony. It was the second number retired by the franchise, joining Patrick Marleau's
- On Mar. 4, 2025, Will Smith recorded a goal and an assist to join Macklin Celebrini to form the third rookie duo in Sharks history to hit the 30-point mark in the same season, the first since 2006-07.

- On Oct. 8, 1991, San Jose won its first-ever game in franchise history against the Flames, 4-3.
- · On Nov. 30, 1991, San Jose posted its first-ever franchise road victory.
- · On Feb. 24, 2007, Patrick Marleau skated in his 700th NHL game (becoming the eighth-youngest skater in NHL history to do so).
- · On Apr. 5, 2007, Joe Thornton had two assists in a 4-3 win to give him 90, making him only the third player in NHL history to have back-to-back 90-assist seasons (Wayne Gretzky, 12 in a row from 1980-81 through 1991-92, and Mario Lemieux, 1988-89 and 1997-98).
- On Jan. 20, 2014, Joe Thornton passed Bobby Hull for 48th place on the NHL's all-time points list (1,171) with a helper while three Sharks defensemen tallied assists in the game.
- · On Dec. 6, 2014, Patrick Marleau tied Glenn Anderson for 24th all-time on the NHL's game-winning goals list with his 82nd game-winner to beat the Flames 3-2.
- · On Dec. 20, 2016, Joe Thornton had a pair of assists in his 1400th career NHL game as the Sharks offense exploded for four goals in the second period on the way to a 4-1 win. Patrick Marleau scored his 490th career goal to tie Norm Ullman for 47th all-time in NHL history.
- · On Mar. 16, 2018, Evander Kane became just the 4th San Jose Shark to score four goals in a game, prior to that he had never had a hat trick. Chris Tierney registered his 100th career NHL point (assist) in a 7-4 win over the Flames.
- · On Feb. 7, 2019, Brent Burns achieved his 50th assist of the season, and became just the seventh defenseman in NHL history to record 50 assists in 55 team games or fewer. In the same contest, Joe Thornton recorded his 1,000th point as a Shark on the first goal of the game to become the second Sharks skater in history to achieve 1,000 points with the franchise.
- · On Feb. 4, 2020, Joe Thornton recorded his 1,500th NHL point and 800th assist as a Shark. Evander Kane skated in his 700th career NHL game and Brent Burns achieved his 500th point as a Shark.
- · On Dec. 7, 2021, Tomáš Hertl netted his fourth-career hat trick, first against a Western Conference team, in a 5-3 win for the Sharks.
- On Dec. 18, 2022, Erik Karlsson recorded his 700th career NHL point with an assist on a Sharks goal in a 5-2 loss to Calgary. Karlsson became the 27th defenseman in NHL history to reach the mark, and only the third Swedish-born defenseman to do so.
- On Mar. 25, 2023, Erik Karlsson took sole possession of first for assists in a season by a defenseman by recording his 67th helper of the 2022-23 campaign.
- · On Apr. 18, 2024, Mikael Granlund extended his point streak to a career-long 13 games, setting a Sharks franchise record for longest point streak by a forward.
- · On Apr. 9, 2025, Macklin Celebrini recorded two assists to break a tie with Pat Falloon (34; 1991-92) and set a Sharks rookie record with 36 for the season.

- On Nov. 1, 2009, Logan Couture recorded his first NHL point (an assist).
- · On Nov. 16, 2014, rookie goaltender Troy Grosenick, in his first career NHL start, stopped all 45 Carolina shots en route to a 2-0 Sharks victory.
- · On Oct. 24, 2015, Joel Ward recorded a hat trick, including his 100th career goal and ten different Sharks had points in a 5-2 Sharks victory
- On Dec. 10, 2016, Patrick Marleau scored 12 seconds into the game, the third quickest goal in franchise history and Joe Thornton had 2 assists in a 4-3 win.
- · On Dec. 7, 2017, Joe Thornton registered three points (1g, 2a) to tie and then pass Dale Hawerchuk for sole possession of 19th place on the NHL all-time points list (1,410). It was the Sharks' first ever win after trailing by three goals at the end of the first period.
- · On Oct. 16, 2019, Evander Kane scored the franchise's first hat trick in the opening frame, becoming the eighth Shark to score three goals in a single period.
- · On Oct. 17, 2023, Tomáš Hertl moved up in the Sharks' all-time ranks for points (to sixth) and multi-assist games (seventh).
- · On Mar. 20, 2025, Luca Cagnoni made his NHL debut and logged two blocked shots with one shot on goal in 23:15 TOI.

- · On Oct. 4, 1999, in a 7-1 victory, Owen Nolan and Jeff Friesen had hat tricks, the first multiple hat trick game in franchise history.
- · On Feb. 3, 2007, Vesa Toskala became the first Sharks goaltender to record a multi-point game with two assists.
- · On Dec. 22, 2009, the Sharks pulled out a 3-2 win in Chicago despite being outshot by the largest margin in franchise history (33), 47-14.
- On Mar. 14, 2011, Logan Couture became just the 23rd rookie to score 20-plus road goals.
- On Jan. 31, 2015, Antti Niemi, on his 31st birthday and the 31st day of January, against fellow Fin Antti Raanta (who wears #31 like Niemi), made 31 saves to capture his 31st career shutout against his former team in a 2-0 Sharks victory.
- · On Dec. 18, 2016, Brent Burns' assist on Joe Pavelski's goal gave him the most career points by a defenseman in Sharks history

- On Dec. 18, 2000, Todd Harvey scored the franchise's 2,000th goal in a 5-3 victory.
- On **Dec. 30, 2009**, in a 5-2 Sharks win, the Sharks attempted and converted two penalty shots for the first time in franchise history (**Ryane Clowe** and **Joe Thornton**). The last time this occurred in the NHL was Feb. 11, 1982 (VAN @ DET, Thomas Gradin and Ivan Hlinka for Vancouver).
- On Jan. 7, 2012, three defensemen scored in a single game for just the fifth time in franchise history as the Sharks (Jason Demers, Brent Burns, Marc-Edouard Vlasic) defeated Washington, 5-2.
- On Feb. 11, 2015, Joe Thornton moved past Peter Stastny for 36th on the NHL's All-Time Points list with a goal and an assist.
- On Mar. 9, 2017, Brent Burns had three assists and Logan Couture had two goals as the Sharks defeated the Capitals 4-2. Joe Thornton, who was honored before the game for reaching 1000 career NHL assists, had a goal and an assist. Jannik Hansen made his debut as a Shark and had an assist and 5 hits.
- On Jan. 22, 2019, Evander Kane's game-winning goal in the third period was just the third time in franchise history the Sharks have scored at 19:59 in the third to force overtime.
- On Jan. 5, 2020, Evander Kane registered his second hat trick of the season, all of which came in the second period. He joined only Joe Pavelski (2013-14) in which he scored multiple hat tricks in a single season with both instances occurring in one period of play.
- On Mar. 15, 2025, Macklin Celebrini reached the 50-point mark to become the first rookie forward in the league to reach the milestone for the season. Zack Ostapchuk made his Sharks debut.

- On Jan 10, 2004, the Sharks set a franchise record for most consecutive games recording a point at home (13, 8-0-3-2).
- On Feb. 21, 2009, Jeremy Roenick recorded his 700th career assist.
- · On Jan. 23, 2014, along with scoring his 19th goal in 21 games, Joe Pavelski became the second player in Sharks history to score game-winning goals in three consecutive games and extended his point-scoring streak to four games (7g, 1a).
- · On Mar. 27, 2014, Joe Thornton played in his 1,200th career game.
- · On Oct. 11, 2014, Alex Stalock and the Sharks shutout the Jets 3-0 in the Sharks' home opener. On top of it being the first time the Sharks have started out the season with back-to-back shutouts, San Jose also became the 6th team in NHL history to start out the season with back-to-back shutouts. It was also the first time since November of 2006 that the Sharks had posted back-to-back shutouts with two different goalies (Evgeni Nabokov on Nov. 25 and Vesa Toskala on Nov. 28).
- · On Mar. 6, 2017, Joe Thornton played in his 900th game as a Shark and registered his 1000th NHL assist in a 3-1 win over the Jets. Joe Pavelski scored a pair of goals, while Mikkel Boedker scored the eventual game winner on a shorthanded breakaway goal.
- On Dec. 20, 2018, Joe Thornton tied Marcel Dionne (1,040) for 10th on the NHL's all-time assist list.
- On Feb. 5, 2019, Joe Pavelski became just the second Sharks skater to score the overtime goal while shorthanded (Alyn McCauley, 11/2/05 vs NSH; 3-2 OTW). It also was the first instance in franchise history where the Sharks scored the overtime goal in three consecutive games and won.
- · On Feb. 5, 2019, Pete DeBoer logged his 300th game as head coach of the Sharks.
- On Apr. 10, 2023, Erik Karlsson recorded his 100th career point (goal) to become the sixth defenseman in league history to achieve 100 points in a season. It was the second 100-point season by a Shark in regular season history, joining Joe Thornton. Tristen Robins made his NHL debut.
- · On Feb. 14, 2024, Mario Ferraro appeared in his 300th NHL career game.
