CAPTAIN CLUTCH

Sidney Crosby single handedly led the Penguins to victory on Thursday night against Anaheim, scoring both Penguins goals including the overtime game winner.

- Crosby has two overtime goals on the season, with his first coming against the Buffalo Sabres on October 16. He is one of three players in the NHL to have multiple overtime tallies in 2024-25 (Leon Draisaitl, 2; Sebastian Aho, 2).
- His tally was his 22nd career overtime goal, which is just four back of Alex Ovechkin for the most in NHL history. His 46 overtime points are the most in NHL history:

BANG BANG KRIS LETANG

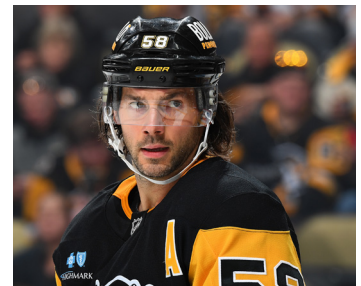
Defenseman Kris Letang is set to play in his 1,100th career game tonight against his hometown Montreal Canadiens.

- Letang will become the sixth active defenseman, and 73rd blueliner in NHL history, to skate in 1,100 career games.
- Through 1,099 career games, Letang has tallied 168 goals, 578 assists and 746 points. Among the six active defensemen to skate in 1,100 career games, Letang's 746 are the most entering the player's milestone game:

Sidney Crosby recorded his second-consecutive multi-point night on Thursday with his first two-goal game of the season.

- Crosby's two-goal game marked his fourth multi-point game of the season and 474th of his career, surpassing Joe Sakic [473] for sole possession of the eighth most in NHL history.
- Thursday was Crosby's 102nd career multi-goal game, which ranks second among active players and 24th in NHL history:
