

TOP NOTES

In his last five games including his goal in today's game, **Ryan McLeod** has recorded five points (1+4), including one point in three consecutive games.

McLeod's three-game point streak marked his third point streak of three or more games this season and the fourth of his career.

Bowen Byram's assist on McLeod's goal gave him one assist in back-toback games. Today's game marked his fourth multi-assist game with Buffalo.

Jacob Bryson also assisted on McLeod's goal and his assist extended his assist streak against Vegas to three games. His current three-game assist streak against the Golden Knights is tied for the longest active assist streak against Vegas among all NHL defensemen (Miro Heiskanen).

As a result of his goal, Jason Zucker has recorded one point in four straight games against Vegas (3+1). It marked the first time that Zucker has tied a game in the third period this season.

Rasmus Dahlin's goal marked the first time a Sabres defenseman had scored to tie a game in the last minute of a game since Tyler Myers did so on Jan. 18, 2014 vs. Columbus. It was the seventh time a Sabres defenseman had done so in franchise history.

Including his goal, **Dahlin** has registered 21 points (6+15) in his last 20 games and 17 points (3+14) in his last 15 home games.

Tage Thompson registered an assist on Dahlin's game-tying goal and he has posted 34 points (18+16) in his last 30 games, including 19 points (12+7) in his last 15.

Alex Tuch's shootout tally marked his third game-deciding shootout goal as a member of the Sabres.

Tuch has converted on seven of his 13 shootout attempts (53.8 percent) with Buffalo, which is good for the highest conversion rate among any Sabres skater with at least 10 shootout attempts with Buffalo.

The Sabres have earned a win in four of their last five games against the Golden Knights. Buffalo has earned at least one point in six of the seven home games it has played against Vegas all-time (5-1-1).
