THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Buffalo has registered 30 or more shots in six consecutive games against St. Louis

The Sabres have recorded eight power-play goals in their last eight games, including at least one in each of their last four games.

Rasmus Dahlin has notched 11 points (3+8) in his last eight games, including at least one point in four straight games (2+4).

If **Dahlin** records a point in today's game, it will mark the first time he has notched a point streak of five or more games since Oct. 14 to 29, 2023 (eight games; 2+7).

Tage Thompson is riding an eight-game home point streak and he has registered 12 points (7+5) in that span.

If he records a point in today's game, **Thompson** would become the first Sabres skater to register a home point streak of eight

or more games since Jack Eichel from Dec. 31, 2019 to Feb. 4, 2020 (nine games; 6+5).

In his last six home games, **Jason Zucker** has posted six points (3+3).

JJ Peterka has registered at least one point in four consecutive games and he has tallied six points in that span (3+3).

Owen Power has collected at least one assist in back-to-back games and an assist in tonight's game would give him his sixth assist streak of three or more games in his career.



In his last five games, **Alex Tuch** has posted five points (1+4).

Tuch has recorded six points (2+4) in his last six games against the Blues.

Bowen Byram has registered four points (2+2) in his last four games.

Dylan Cozens (2+1) and **Zach Benson** (1+2) have each recorded three points in their last three games.

In six career games against St. Louis, **Cozens** has registered six points (3+3).

The Sabres are 7-4-8 all-time on November 14.

November 14, 1998: Michal Grosek (2+1) and Brian Holzinger (1+2) each record three points and Dominik Hasek and Dwayne Roloson combine to make 20 saves on 21 shots as the Sabres defeat the Blackhawks 6-1.

November 14, 2009: Tyler Ennis scores in his NHL debut and the Sabres top the Flyers 3-2 in Philadelphia.



DAHLIN WITH IT, ROCK WITH IT

Rasmus Dahlin currently ranks 14th all-time among defensemen in franchise history in games played (452) and he is 14 games away from tying Dmitri Kalinin for 13th place on Buffalo's all-time list.

Among Sabres defensemen all-time, **Dahlin** ranks third in points (305) and he trails only Mike Ramsey (329) and Phil Housley (558).

Dahlin's 69 goals are the third-most by a defenseman in Sabres history and he is four goals away from tying Ramsey for second place on Buffalo's all-time list for defensemen.



Dahlin posted 302 points (68+234) through his first 450 career games and among players who began their career with Buffalo, **Dahlin** is just the ninth Sabres skater to record 300 or more points in their first 450 games with the Sabres.
