AT A GLANCE

THE OHIO ST(REAK)

The Kings kick off their five-game road trip fresh off a 2-1 victory over the Panthers on Jan. 22. With their victory, the Kings extended their point streak against Florida to an eighth game (7-0-1), dating back to Feb. 20, 2020. It is the third longest active point-streak against any one opponent for the Kings and is one of six such streaks of at least seven games in length. Among those is a seven-game (6-0-1) run against tomorrow's foe, the Columbus Blue Jackets, dating back to March 4, 2022. With a 14-3-3 record, the Kings have collected points in 17 of their last 20 meetings with the Blue Jackets, dating back to Feb. 6, 2014.

HEL YEAH BROTHER!

Rookie forward **Samuel Helenius** (59th overall) scored his first career NHL goal Wednesday night vs. Florida, becoming the 14th player of Finnish nationality to score a goal for the LA Kings. He is also the second player selected by the Kings in the 2021 NHL Draft to score a goal for the franchise behind defenseman **Brandt Clarke** (2nd overall). Measuring at 6'6, Helenius is tied with **Brian Boyle** as the second-tallest player to score a goal for the Kings, trailing only **Steve McKenna** (6'8). In 25 games this season, the first-year forward now has one goal and a pair of assists (1-2=3) with 73 hits, nine blocks and 16 shots on goal. Among all League rookies, Helenius' 73 hits rank sixth-most.
