PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars have the day off on Sunday, March 17. They'll return to practice on Monday, March 18 at 11 a.m. CT at Comerica Center.

NOTES

- With a 4-1 victory over the Kings, the Stars have won eight of the past 10 head-to-head matchups against the Kings (8-2-0) and 14 of the previous 18 overall (14-4-0). At home, Dallas has won five in a row vs. LA and has taken six of the past seven (6-1-0) at AAC.

- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** became the third blueliner in franchise history with 15 goals in a season at age 22 or younger, joining **Brad Maxwell** (18 in 1977-78) and **Craig Hartsburg** (17 in 1981-82). Harley, who had a goal and assist (1-1—2), leads Stars blueliners in goals (15) and ranks second in points (15-23-38).

- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** (1-0—1) scored the 50th goal of his NHL career and became the third player in franchise history to reach the milestone before age 21, following **Brian Bellows** (102) and **Mike Modano** (57). The 20-year-old shares the team lead in goals (26) with **Roope Hintz**.

- Captain **Jamie Benn** tallied his 374th career goal and 892nd point (374-518—892) with a power-play tally in the middle frame. Benn occupies second place on the franchise's all-time goals and points lists behind **Mike Modano**, who had a statue unveiled in his honor outside American Airlines Center during the first intermission.

- Forward **Joe Pavelski** (0-1—1) picked up his 34th assist of the season. The 39-year-old has points in four of his past five games (3-4—7) and 58 points (24-34—58) overall.

- Forward **Jason Robertson** (0-1—1) earned his team-leading 45th assist and 68th point (23-45—68)

- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** (0-2—2) recorded his 11th multi-point game of the season with two assists.

Heiskanen paces Stars blueliners with 46 points (7-39—46) in 58 GP.
