AT A GLANCE

SHORTHANDED FINNISH

Forward **Joel Armia** will face off against the Senators fresh off scoring his League-leading third shorthanded goal, and 10th point (5-5=10), of the season last Friday against the Boston Bruins. It also marked Armia's second shorthanded tally in as many games and calendar days following his man-down marker on Thursday in San Jose. By doing so, Armia became the fourth Kings player since 2000-01 to score a shorthanded goal in consecutive games, following **Trevor Moore** (2 GP in 2021-22), **Mike Richards** (2 GP in 2011-12) and **Ziggy Palffy** (2 GP in 2000-01). Furthermore, Armia also joined **Steve Duchesne** (2 GP from Nov. 22-23, 1988) and **Bernie Nicholls** (2 GP from Dec. 5-6, 1987) as the third player in Kings history to score a shorthanded goal in consecutive calendar days.

SENS-ING A PATTERN


The Kings return to action tomorrow at Crypto.com Arena riding an 11-game point streak (8-0-3) against Ottawa, dating back to Nov. 7, 2019. It is the longest active point streak against any one opponent for the Kings and is the second-longest active point streak among all League teams against the Senators behind Vegas (12GP, 11-0-1). Should the team collect a point versus the Atlantic Division's Senators on Monday, it would mark the fifth different point streak of at least 12 games against any one opponent in franchise history. The Kings' 26.8 PP% against Ottawa at home all-time also places second among all teams (min. GP: 10).

KING OF KINGS

Captain **Anze Kopitar** hosts the Ottawa Senators for the final time in his career tonight having averaged a point-per-game (7-21=28) through his previous 28 cross-conference clashes against the club from Canada's capital. The captain has posted consecutive multi-point games against the Senators at Crypto.com Arena (1-1=2 on Nov. 30, 2024, and 0-2=2 on March 7, 2024) and has seven points (1-6=7) in his last four home games against Ottawa, dating back to Nov. 27, 2021. Since the 2019-20 season, Kopitar has scored 16 points (3-13=16) in 11 contests against the Senators, with all three of the captain's goals standing as the game-winner in that stretch.
