MATCHUP NOTES

- Columbus has recorded points in five of the last eight games of the all-time series (3-3-2).
- The winning team has won by multiple goals in eight of the last nine games at Nationwide Arena since Feb. 14, 2020.
- The winning team has recorded four or more goals (including SO goals) in nine of the past ten games overall and 13 of the last 15 games of the series dating back to Oct. 29, 2021.
- The winning team has also recorded four-plus goals in five consecutive meetings at Nationwide Arena.
- The Blue Jackets have recorded the three most recent hat tricks (MR: Adam Fantilli in 7-3 win at NYR on Mar. 9, 2025) and penalty shot attempt (Brandon Saad, unsuccessful in 5-2 win at NYR on Feb. 26, 2017).
- CBJ have killed off 17 of 19 (89.5 pct.) NYR power plays in last nine games, including all six attempts in the past four meetings of the series.

JACKET TO WATCH C Sean Monahan

Has posted 4-8-12 in 17 GP against the Rangers and has collected points in each of his past three games (2-2-4). Has scored in each of his last three home games against the club.





RANGER TO WATCH - LW Artemi Panarin

Has tallied 15-15-30 with 10 multi-point efforts in 22 career GP vs. Columbus. Has registered points in seven of his past ten appearances against the club (6-6-12).



TEAM NOTES

- Columbus has earned points in its last three outings (2-0-1) after defeating Edmonton 5-4 on Thursday.
- The club has won three consecutive home games and four of the past five at NWA since Oct. 18.
- Eight of the Jackets' last ten games have been decided by a single goal (5-2-1 in those contests).
- CBJ completed a stretch of seven-straight games against the Western Conference on Thursday. The team plays 13 of the next 14 contests against the East from Nov. 15-Dec. 11, including six vs. the Metropolitan Division.
- Columbus has killed off 17-of-18 opponent power plays over the last nine contests and leads the NHL in penalty kill percentage (94.4 pct.) since Oct. 26.
- The Blue Jackets, who are 4-1-0 in Saturday games, play on seven consecutive Saturdays to begin the season and 22 of the 24 available in 2025-26 (Nov. 29 and Dec. 27).

PLAYER NOTES

- C Charlie Coyle posted his second three-point game of the season (0-4-4 on Oct. 29 vs. TOR) with 1-2-3 on Thursday and has registered points in three-straight home contests (2-6-8).
- C Adam Fantilli extended his goal streak to three consecutive and points streak to four-straight (3-3-6) with his second period goal on Thursday. It's one goal shy of his career-long goal streak set Apr. 12-17, 2025.
- D Denton Mateychuk is tied with Zach Werenski for the team lead in goals among defensemen (4) and has picked up points in four of his past six games played (2-2-4).
- RW Kirill Marchenko (8-11-19, 17 GP) extended his career-high points streak to 10 games with an assist on Fantilli's goal to become the fifth different player in Blue Jackets history with a point streak of 10 or more games (Ryan Johansen, 13 GP in 2014-15 and 10 GP in 2014-15; Cam Atkinson, 12 GP in 2018-19; Patrik Laine, 11 GP in 2021-22; R.J. Umberger, 10 GP in 2010-11).
- RW Mathieu Olivier has three-point outings in two of the last three home games (3-4-7) after posting 2-1-3 on Thursday.
