PLAYER NOTES

- John Tavares scored on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 5:25 of the second period and scored his second goal of the game at 13:42 of the third period, improving to 17 goals scored this season. With his first goal of the game, Tavares scored his 200th goal as a Maple Leaf and became the fifth player in NHL history to score 200 goals for two franchises, joining Wayne Gretzky, Lanny McDonald, Mark Messier and Keith Tkachuk. Tavares extended his current point streak to five games where he has recorded nine points (5G, 4A). Tavares marked his fourth multi-goal game of the season and his ninth multi-point game of the season. Per NHL Stats, "Tavares tallied his 67th career multi-goal game, which rank sixth among active players behind Alex Ovechkin (177), Sidney Crosby (103), Steven Stamkos (98), Auston Matthews (78) and Evgeni Malkin (74)."
- **Mitch Marner** recorded the primary assist on Tavares' first goal of the game. In posting his 36th assist of the season, Marner currently holds sole possession of second in the league among assist leaders. Marner is currently on a six-game assist streak where he has posted eight assists.
- William Nylander registered the secondary assist on Tavares' first goal of the game and the secondary assist on Tavares' second goal of the game, improving to 17 assists registered this season. Nylander extended his current point streak to seven games where he has recorded 12 points (6G, 6A). Nylander marked his third multi-assist game of the season and his 14th multi-point game of the season.
- Jake McCabe recorded the primary assist on Tavares' second goal of the game, posting his ninth assist of the season. McCabe has recorded an assist in back-to-back games.
- Joseph Woll stopped 22 of 26 shots he faced in tonight's loss.
- Oliver Ekman-Larsson and Jake McCabe were on the ice for a team-high 30 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Steven Lorentz** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 82.35 percent (14 for, 3 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs were 1-for-3 on the power play and 1-for-2 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted a 14-6-0 record on home ice this season.
