AT A GLANCE

THE 11TH HOUR

In the Kings' final game of the 2024 calendar year on Dec. 29 vs. Philadelphia, captain **Anze Kopitar** notched his 11th and 12th goals of the season to mark the 50th multi-goal performance of his career. Both of the captain's goals came in the final frame of Sunday's contest, marking his 23rd career multi-goal period to surpass **Dave Taylor** (22) for most such periods in Kings history. As part of his two-goal effort, Kopitar tallied his 430th and 431st career NHL goals and is now tied with Taylor (431) for the third-most goals in LA Kings history. With the second of the pair coming on the man-advantage, Kopitar (123) also tied Taylor (123) for the third most *power play* goals in franchise history. Kopitar finished the 2024 calendar year with 24 goals and 51 assists for 75 points (24-51=75), placing second among all Kings skaters behind **Adrian Kempe**'s 77 points (33-44=77). He skates into DTLA with a team-leading 27 assists and 39 points (12-27=39) and is one point shy from hitting the 40-point mark in a single season for the 19th time in his career.

HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Coming off a back-to-back sweep (4-3 W on Dec. 28 vs. EDM; 5-4 W on Dec. 29 vs. PHI) over the weekend at Crypto.com Arena, the Kings aim to extend their

home winning streak to eight games as they continue their five-game homestand against the New Jersey Devils tomorrow. With their pair of victories, the Kings improved their 2024-25 home record to 12-2-1 with a .833 points percentage (PTS%), tied for the highest in the League with Vegas (.833%).

YULE LOG-GING MINUTES

Defensemen **Vladislav Gavrikov** (23:45) and **Mikey Anderson** (22:58) sit first and second, respectively, in average time-on-ice (TOI) this season among all Kings skaters. Each blueliner has averaged over 23 minutes of TOI in each of their last four games, including Anderson's third- and fourth-highest TOI in a single game of his career recorded in last weekend's back-to-back (27:20 on Dec. 29 vs. PHI; 27:18 on Dec. 28 vs. EDM). Approaching the midpoint of the campaign, no other defenseman has accrued a higher net plus/minus rating than Gavrikov's plus-15 while playing as many minutes or more each night.
