MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ The home team has earned points in six of the eight all-time meetings between the clubs (5-2-1).
- ★ Columbus snapped a five-game losing streak in the series in the most recent meeting on Jan. 9, 2025.
- ★ The teams split the season series for the first time in 2024-25 after Columbus swept the 2021-22 series and Seattle won both games of the 2022-23 and 2023-24 series.
- ★ The teams have combined for seven-plus goals in three of the past four matchups and six-plus goals in six of the past seven.
- ★ The winning team has recorded four or more goals in five-straight games and six of the last seven.
- ★ The teams have combined for less than 60 shots in five of the eight contests of the series.
- ★ Neither team has recorded a hat trick, shutout, or penalty shot in the series.



JACKET TO WATCH D Ivan Provorov

Has recorded 3-3-6 in 8 career GP against the Kraken, including a point in the last outing on Jan. 9, 2025. Has collected 1-1-2 in four career games at Seattle.



KRAKEN TO WATCH - RW Jordan Eberle

Has tallied 13-20-33 with 9 multi-point efforts in 35 career GP vs. Columbus. Has registered points in each of his past six appearances against the club (4-5-9).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets close out their five-game road trip at Seattle on Tuesday after earning a point in a 5-4 OT loss at Edmonton on Monday.
- ★ Six of CBJ's last eight games have been decided by a single goal (3-2-1 in those contests).
- ★ CBJ, who play 15 back-to-back sets this season, are 4-2-1 in back-to-back sets this season. The club is 2-1-0 in the second game of a back-to-back (1-1-0 on the road).
- ★ Monday's game at Edmonton began a stretch of six games in nine days for Columbus through Nov. 18.
- ★ Columbus has killed off 13-of-14 opponent power plays over the last seven contests and leads the NHL in penalty kill percentage (92.9 pct.) since Oct. 26.
- ★ CBJ blueliners combined for 1-3-4 on Monday. They have recorded 12-19-31 in 15 games and lead the league in goals scored and percentage of team goals (25.5).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** posted multiple points for the second-straight game (1-3-4), and fourth time this season, with 1-1-2 at Edmonton. He has notched 3-7-10 in 15 games this season, including 1-4-5 in the past four outings.
- ★ **C Boone Jenner** tallied his third multi-point effort of the campaign on Monday with 1-1-2 and has registered assists in three of the last four games (1-3-4).
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** has set a new career high with points in eight-straight games (3-7-10) after collecting an assist on Monday. He has registered points in 13 of the 15 games in 2025-26 (8-9-17) and leads CBJ in goals, assists and points.
- ★ **D Damon Severson** is one game shy of 800 for his NHL career (74-246-320, 799 GP). He sits sixth overall - and fourth among defensemen - in games played by players selected in the 2012 NHL Draft.
- ★ **D Zach Werenski**, who collected an assist on Monday, ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP (26:22) as well as first among league blueliners in shots on goal (55).
