PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars will travel tonight to Colorado to meet the Avalanche on the second night of a back-to-back tomorrow night at Ball Arena at 8:30 pm CT.

NOTES

- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** lit the lamp (1-0—1) in the second period and notched his 800th career NHL point (339-462—800). In his first season in a Dallas Stars uniform, he has posted 56 points (23-33—56).
- Stars rookie forward **Logan Stankoven** potted his first NHL goal and registered his first NHL assist (1-1—2) on Monday night against the Islanders.
- The native of Kamloops, British Columbia becomes the 18th player in NHL history to record their first career goal on their birthday (last: Zack Bolduc, STL, Feb. 24, 2024). The only other player to do so in Stars/North Stars franchise history is Raymond Sawada on Feb. 19, 2009 vs Edmonton.
- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** added an assist (0-1—1) and now has inked the scoresheet in six of last seven home games (4-5=9). In 57 games this season, the blueliner has recorded 35 points (14-21—35).
- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** added a helper (0-1—1) and has eight points (4-4—8) over his last seven games. This season, the forward has 41 points (19-22—41) in 60 contests.
- Goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** turned aside 25 of the 28 shots that he faced on Monday. In 27 appearances this season, Wedgewood has earned a 13-6-5 record.
