### AT A GLANCE

#### **KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE**

After posting their sixth shutout of the season and second in consecutive games against their upcoming Round One opponent (3-0 on April 5) the Kings enter the final two matchups of the regular season having posted 45 games allowing two goals or fewer this year, tied with the Winnipeg Jets for the most such games this season. By stonewalling all 27 of Edmonton's shots on April 5, goaltender **Darcy Kuemper** secured his fifth shutout of the year and improved his record to 28-10-7 on the year to that point. With 26 saves on 28 shots faced last Monday against Seattle and a 24-save outing on Thursday, April 10, against Anaheim, Kuemper is joined by **Miikka Kiprusoff** (16 GS in 2003-04) as the only two goaltenders in the NHL's expansion era (since 1967-68) to have 15 or more consecutive starts of allowing two or fewer goals. In last night's 5-0 victory over the Oilers, Kuemper (16 saves) and **David Rittich** (5 saves) turned aside all shots to combine for the third shared shutout in Kings history, following Oct. 28, 1998, and Feb. 20, 1980.

#### **JUICE IS LOOSE**

Last night in Edmonton, forward **Adrian Kempe** (1-2=3) contributed two power play assists, his 36th and 37th helpers of the year, before burying his 34th goal and 71st point (34-37=71) of the year in the final frame. With his second three-point effort of the season, Kempe clinched his second consecutive 70-point campaign (28-47=75 in 2023-24) and now has six helpers and seven points (1-6=7) over his last three consecutive appearances, dating back to April 10 vs. Anaheim. The winger skates into Climate Pledge Arena with three goals in his last four games versus Seattle, dating to April 3, 2024, and owns 10 points (5-5=10) in 13 career matchups against the Kraken. With his next point, Kempe will become the 14th skater in Kings history to record 400 points with the franchise, joining linemate Anze Kopitar (440-838=1,278) as the only player born outside of North America to do so in franchise history.
