GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the fourth and final game that the Stars will play against the Jets this season and the second time they are playing in Dallas this year.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with a 50-22-6 record for 106 points and a .679 points percentage. Their 50 wins were the second-most in the NHL and their point total and points percentage ranked third in the NHL this season entering play Wednesday.
- Jamie Benn enters tonight's game one goal shy of scoring his 400th career goal. When he reaches the milestone, he will become...
 - The second player in franchise history to score 400 goals, joining Mike Modano (557). 438 of Modano's 557 goals were scored with the Star after the team relocated to Dallas.
 - o The second player drafted in 2007 to score 400 goals, with the other being Detroit's Patrick Kane (491).
 - The 10th active skater to score 400 career goals.
- Mason Marchment has been playing at a point-per-game pace since March 14, totaling 14 points (6-8—14) in 14 games.
- Mikko Rantanen has tallied 15 points (5-10—15) in 16 games with the Stars since being acquired by Dallas prior to the 2025 NHL Trade Deadline.
- In 23 games since the Four Nations break (since Feb. 22), the Stars have outscored their opponents 29-13 at even strength when Cody Ceci has been on the ice. His plus-16 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the second-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Wednesday.
- Entering play Wednesday, the Stars ranked in the top five in the NHL this season in goals for per game (3.42, third) and in goals against per game (2.59, fourth).

PLAYOFF BOUND

• Dallas became the third team to clinch a berth to the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs with their 5-1 win over the Kraken in their game on March 29.

- 2024-25 season marks the 37th postseason appearance in franchise history and their fifth time in the past five seasons
 tied for the most among all teams in that span according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have made the Conference Finals in each of their past two postseasons and can become the fifth team in the
 past 20 years to do so in three straight (also TBL, CHI, LAK & DET) according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have won nine series in the past 10 years, tied with the Penguins for the third most in the NHL in that span according to NHL Stats behind only the Lightning (18) and Golden Knights (11).

GROUNDING THE JETS

- Dallas is 33-21-5 all-time vs. Winnipeg, including a 19-8-2 mark at home.
- The Stars have earned points in 11 of their last 15 games against the Jets (9-4-2). Dallas has also earned points in 10 of their last 11 games played vs. Winnipeg at American Airlines Center (9-1-1).
- Roope Hintz has scored in each of his last two games against the Jets and has totaled five points (3-2-5) in his last five games played vs. Winnipeg.
- Jason Robertson has 13 points (9-4—13) in 14 career games against Winnipeg.
 - Robertson's nine goals against the Jets since the start of the 2019-20 season are tied for the 10th-most in the NHI
- Mikko Rantanen has registered 28 points (10-18—28) in 30 career games played against Winnipeg.
 - o Rantanen's 28 points against the Jets since the 2016-17 rank tied for the 10th most in the NHL.
- Thomas Harley has recorded five points (1-4-5) in 10 career games against the Jets.
- Wyatt Johnston has five points (3-2-5) in 10 career games vs. Winnipeg.
- Mason Marchment enters tonight's contest riding a two-game point streak against the Jets. In all, Marchment has nine points (5-4—9) in 13 career games vs. Winnipeg.
- Matt Duchene has recorded 36 points (17-19—36) in 46 career games against the Jets. His 36 points vs. Winnipeg rank third among active Stars skaters.
- Cody Ceci has registered four points (0-4—4) in his last five games played against the Jets.
- Jake Oettinger has posted a 6-3-1 record in 10 career games against Winnipeg, posting a 2.42 goals-against average and a .908 save percentage in those contests.

I WANNA BE LIKE MIKE

- Mikael Granlund had a three-point outing (1-2—3) in Dallas' last game on April 8 against Vancouver and now has 12 points (6-6—12) in his last 12 games played dating back to March 18.
 - o Granlund's performance against the Canucks was his third three-point game of the season and his first as a member of the Stars.
- Granlund's six goals since March 18 are the most of any Stars skater during that span and his 12 points are tied for second on the team.
- Additionally, since March 18 the Stars have outscored their opponents 11-3 at even strength when **Granlund** has been on the ice. His plus-8 even-strength on-ice goal differential was tied for the second-best mark on Dallas' roster during that span, trailing only **Thomas Harley** (plus-10) for the team lead.
- Granlund's goal against the Canucks was his 22nd of the season, which is his second-highest total in a single season in his career, trailing only the 26 goals he scored with the Minnesota Wild in 2016-17.
- The 2024-25 season is already the third-highest scoring season of **Granlund's** 13-year career, and he enters tonight's game three points shy of matching his career high of 69 that he set in 2016-17.

DOUBLE DUTCH

- Matt Duchene enters tonight's game riding a seven-game point streak, recording 10 points (3-7—10) during that span, which was tied for the fourth-longest active point streak in the NHL entering play Wednesday.
- If he were to have a goal or an assist tonight, it would give him points in eight consecutive games for the first time since April 16 to 29, 2022.
- A point tonight would also make **Duchene** the third Stars skater this season to have a point streak of at least eight games, joining **Wyatt Johnston** (9; 2/8/25 to 3/8/25) and **Jason Robertson** (8; 2/23/25 to 3/9/25).
- In all, **Duchene** has 81 points (30-51—81) in 78 games this year, which makes the 2024-25 campaign the second-highest scoring season of his 16-year career, trailing only the 86 points he had with Nashville in 2021-22.
- Duchene's second assist in Dallas' April 3 game against the Predators was his 48th assist of the season, which set a career high for the forward.
- **Duchene's** goal in Dallas' last game was his 30th of the season, making the 2024-25 campaign the fourth time he has reached the 30-goal mark.

BIKER GANG

- Thomas Harley tallied an assist in Dallas' last game and now has 27 points (9-18—27) in his last 28 games played dating back to Jan. 31, which is tied for fourth on Dallas' roster during that span.
 - Harley's 27 points (9-18-27) since Jan. 31 were tied with Buffalo's Rasmus Dahlin for the second-most during that span among all NHL defensemen entering play Wednesday, trailing only Colorado's Cale Makar (35).

- Harley enters tonight's game riding a three-game point streak. A goal or an assist tonight would give him points in four
 consecutive games for the second time this season. It would also match his career-long point streak that he has reached
 on three previous occasions.
- Harley's assist against the Canucks was his 50th point of the season, making him the third Stars defensemen in the last 10 years to reach the 50-point plateau, joining Miro Heiskanen (2022-23 and 2023-24) and John Klingberg (2015-16 and 2017-18).
 - Harley's assist also allowed him to tie Gary Sargen (71) for 25th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- Harley set a career high with his 16th goal of the season in Dallas' game on April 6 against the Wild. His 16 goals this year are tied for the sixth-most by a Stars defenseman in a single season in franchise history and were tied for the fifth-most among all NHL defensemen this year entering play Wednesday.
- Harley's assist against Pittsburgh on April 5 was his 33rd assist and 48th point of the season, both of which set career highs for the defenseman.
- Since Jan. 31 Dallas' first game without **Miro Heiskanen Harley** has been averaging 24:58 of ice time per game, which tops all Stars skaters and ranked ninth in the NHL entering play Wednesday.
 - o Prior to Jan. 31, Harley was averaging 22:27 of ice time per game.
 - Harley skated a career-high 31:11 in Dallas' game on March 20 against the Tampa Bay Lightning. It was the highest time on ice total by a Stars skater in a regular-season game since Heiskanen skated 32:01 on April 11, 2021 against the Nashville Predators.
- When Harley has been on the ice during even-strength play this season, the Stars have outscored their opponents 93-58. His plus-35 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the third-best mark in the NHL this season entering play Wednesday.
- Harley recorded the 100th point of his NHL career with an assist in Dallas' March 26 game against the Oilers, making
 him the third defenseman drafted in 2019 to reach the 100-point milestone, joining Detroit's Moritz Seider and Buffalo's
 Bowen Byram. He also became the 24th defenseman in franchise history to total 100 points with the Stars.
- Harley's 100th career point came in his 188th career regular-season games, making him the fourth-fastest defenseman in Stars/North Stars history to record 100 career points according to NHL Stats, following John Klingberg (145 GP), Craig Hartsburg (170 GP) and Brad Maxwell (170 GP).
- Harley matched his single-game career high with three points (1-2—3) in Dallas' March 18 game against the Ducks, surpassing Larry Murphy (93) for the 25th-most points by a defenseman in team history.
 - o In that game, the Stars outshot the Ducks 15-2 when **Harley** was on the ice during 5-on-5 play according to Natural Stat Trick.
- Harley's game-winning goal in Dallas' March 22 game against the Flyers came just nine seconds into overtime, which set a record for the quickest overtime goal in franchise history according to NHL Stats.
- Harley is one of four defensemen this season to score two overtime goals. In total, he has scored five overtime goals since the start of 2023-24, which leads all NHL defensemen and is tied for fifth in the NHL.
- Harley's two-goal performance against the Flyers brought his season total up to 15, making him the third defenseman
 in franchise history to record consecutive 15-goal seasons according to NHL Stats, joining Phillippe Boucher (2 from
 2005-06 2006-07) and Lou Nanne (1971-72 1972-73).

POWER UP

- Since Jan. 1, the Stars have gone 36-for-1118 on the power play for a 30.5 percent success rate, which was the fourth-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Wednesday.
- The team's 36 power-play goals since Jan. 1 were tied with Detroit for the most in the NHL during that span entering play Wednesday.
- The Stars went a perfect 4-for-4 on the power play in their game on March 2 against the Blues, marking the first time that they have scored four power-play goals in a game since Nov. 12, 2023.
 - Dallas' game against St. Louis marked one of four instances this year in which a team has scored four powerplay goals in a game. The Ottawa Senators (10/14 vs. LAK), Winnipeg Jets (10/18 vs. SJS) and Florida Panthers (12/5 at PHI) all previously did so.
- Their performance against the Blues also was the first time in Stars team history that the team had a 100 percent success rate on the power play in a single game while scoring at least four power-play goals.
- In all this season, the Stars have had three games in which they have scored at least three power-play goals Oct. 24 at Boston (3), March 2 vs. St. Louis (4) and April 8 vs. Vancouver (3).

HOME COOKING

- The Stars have a 28-8-3 record at home this season. Entering play Wednesday, they ranked in the top five in the NHL in home wins (28, fourth), points (59, fourth) and points percentage (.756, fifth).
- Dallas is one home win shy of matching the franchise record of 29 set by the team in 1998-99.
- Since Jan. 24, the Stars have gone 17-for-44 on the power play at the American Airlines Center. Their 38.6 percent success rate on the power play at home was the second-best mark in the NHL during that span, and their 17 home power-play goals were also the second-most entering play Wednesday.

- Jason Robertson (42 points, 39 games played) and Roope Hintz (39 points, 37 games played) are both playing at a
 point-per-game pace at home this year.
 - o Robertson's 42 home points this year are the most of any Stars skater this season.
- Matt Duchene has tallied 22 points (5-17—22) in his last 19 home games and enters tonight's game riding an eight-game home point streak. It is his longest home streak since March 8 to April 5, 2022 while he was playing for the Nashville Predators.
 - A goal or an assist tonight would give him points in nine consecutive home games for the first time in his career.
- Wyatt Johnston has been playing at a point-per-game pace at home since Oct. 27, totaling 34 points (16-18—34) in 34 games
- Thomas Harley has recorded 21 points (6-15—21) in his last 20 home games dating back to Dec. 31. His 21 home points during that span were tied for fourth and fifth, respectively, on the Stars and among all NHL defensemen entering play Wednesday.
 - o Sixteen of those 21 points have come in the 12 home games that he has played since Feb. 2.
 - He has 29 home points (8-21—29) in all this season, which was tied for 10th among NHL defensemen entering play Wednesday.
- Mikael Granlund has eight points (4-4—8) in his last seven home games, which includes posting a three-point performance (1-2—3) in Dallas' last home game on April 8.
- Jamie Benn has six assists in his last six games played at the American Airlines Center dating back to March 6 against the Calgary Flames.
- Mason Marchment (3-1-4) and Mikko Rantanen (1-3-4) both have four points in their last four home games.
- Jake Oettinger has won the last nine games that he has played at the American Airlines Center dating back to Jan. 24, posting a .927 save percentage, a 2.09 goals-against average and one shutout in those games.
 - Oettinger's current nine-game home win streak is the longest such streak of his career.

THIRTY, FLIRTY AND THRIVING

- The Stars enter tonight's game with four players that have scored at least 30 goals this season: **Jason Robertson** (33), **Mikko Rantanen** (32), **Wyatt Johnston** (30) and **Matt Duchene** (30).
 - o The 2024-25 campaign marks the first time the Stars' roster has housed four 30-goal scorers since the 1992-93 season when Russ Courtnall (36), Ulf Dahlen (35), Dave Gagner (33) and Mike Modano (33) all scored at least 30 goals.
- Entering play Wednesday, the Stars and the Tampa Bay Lightning were the only two teams this season to have four 30goal scorers on its roster.
- Entering tonight's game, Roope Hintz is three goals shy of reaching the 30-goal mark. If he were to score 30 goals by
 the end of the regular season, it would mark the first time in franchise history that the Stars would have five 30-goals
 scorers on its roster.
- Additionally, the Stars could become the first team to have five 30-goal scorers on its roster since the Pittsburgh
 Penguins and Detroit Red Wings, who both did so during the 1992-93 season according to NHL Stats. Please note that
 this includes players who did not score all 30+ of their goals with one team.

DADDY ISSUES

- Evgenii Dadonov scored the second hat trick of his career with three goals against the Penguins in Dallas' April 5 game.
 Dadonov's first career hat trick also came against Pittsburgh on Feb. 24, 2018.
 - o It made him the third Stars skater to score a hat trick this season, joining **Wyatt Johnston** and **Jason Robertson** who have each scored two hat tricks this year.
- Dadonov's third goal of the day was his 19th of the season, which makes 2024-25 the fifth-highest ranking season of his career in terms of goal scoring.
 - o Dadonov's next goal will give him his fifth career 20-goal season.
- Dadonov is the sixth-oldest player this season to score at least 19 goals this year, joining Alex Ovechkin (42), Sidney Crosby (31), Anze Kopitar (19), Brad Marchand (21) and Patrick Kane (20).
- Dadonov enters tonight's game one point shy of recording the fifth 40-point season of his career.

SEEING STARS

- Roope Hintz was named the NHL's Second Star of the Week for the week ending on March 30 after tallying nine points (2-7—9) in four games played.
- It is the third time in his career that he has earned Star of the Week honors after previously being named the NHL's Third Star of the Week on April 12, 2021 and the Second Star of the Week on March 3, 2025.
- Hintz is one of 10 players this season to earn Star of the Week honors on multiple occasions.
- **Hintz** joins **Matt Duchene** (week ending on Oct. 27, 2024) and **Mason Marchment** (week ending on Nov. 17, 2024) as the three Dallas players to earn Star of the Week honors this season.
- Hintz has totaled 29 points (6-23—29) in 21 games played since the Four Nation Break. Since Feb. 22, his 23 assists were the third-most in the NHL entering play Wednesday and his 29 points were tied for fifth.

- According to Natural Stat Trick, when Hintz has been on the ice during 5-on-5 play since Feb. 22, the Stars have
 outscored their opponents 17-7.
- Hintz recorded his 200th career assist in Dallas' March 29 game against Seattle. With the assist he became...
 - o The 28th skater in franchise history to total 200 assists with the team.
 - o The 18th skater selected in the 2015 NHL Draft to reach the 200-assist milestone.
 - o The 30th Finnish player in NHL history to have 200 career assists.
- In all this season, Hintz has totaled 65 points (28-37-65) in 72 regular-season games, making the 2024-25 campaign
 his fourth consecutive 60-point season.

IT TAKES TWO

- Jake Oettinger has an 20-6-3 record in his last 29 games played dating back to Dec. 29, posting a .916 save percentage
 and a 2.47 goals-against average during that span.
 - o His 20 wins since Dec. 29 were the third-most in the NHL during that span entering play Wednesday.
- Oettinger made a season-high 41 saves in Dallas' March 26 game, a 4-3 win over the Oilers. The Stars were outshot 44-24 in that game.
- Oettinger made 33 saves for his 12th career shutout in Dallas' March 24 game, a 3-0 win over Minnesota, which tied Jon Casey for the sixth-most shutouts in franchise history.
 - o Oettinger saved 5.74 goals above expected in the game according to MoneyPuck.com.
- Oettinger's shutout was also the 12th of his career, which tied teammate Casey DeSmith for the fifth-most by a U.S.-born goaltender in NHL history according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars' victory over the Wild was also the 146th win of **Oettinger's** career, which passed Cesare Maniago (145) for the fourth-most wins by a goaltender in franchise history.
- Oettinger earned his 30th win of the season in Dallas' game on March 6, a 3-2 overtime win over the Calgary Flames. According to NHL Stats, he became the fourth goaltender in Stars/North Stars history with four or more 30-win seasons, joining Marty Turco (6x), Ed Belfour (4x) and Kari Lehtonen (4x). He also joined Turco (6 from 2002-03 to 2008-09) and Belfour (4 from 1997-98 to 2000-01) as the only netminders to do so in four consecutive campaigns with the franchise.
- Casey DeSmith has posted an 8-1-1 record in his last nine games played dating back to Jan. 25 against the St. Louis Blues, posting a .926 save percentage and a 2.43 goals-against average in those contests.
- **DeSmith** made 46 saves in Dallas' March 27 game against the Flames, a 5-2 Stars win. His 46 saves were the most by a Dallas netminder this season and the third-most in a single game in **DeSmith's** career.
- In all this season, **DeSmith** has saved .61 goals above expected per 60, which was the sixth-best mark in the NHL this season entering play Wednesday among netminders that have played in more than five games.
- In all, Oettinger and DeSmith have combined for a .910 save percentage this season, which was the second-best mark of any team in the NHL this season entering play Wednesday. The duo's 2.57 goals-against average this season ranked fourth in the NHL this year entering play Wednesday.

- The Stars have had an 83.8 percent success rate on the penalty kill this season, which was the second-best mark in the NHL this year entering play Wednesday, trailing only the Carolina Hurricanes (84.9 percent).
- Dallas has also allowed the second-fewest power-play goals against (35), and their -29 goal differential on the penalty kill this year was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Wednesday.
- If the Stars maintain this pace, it would make the 2024-25 season their best on the penalty kill since 2007-08, when the team finished the season with an 85.6 percent success rate on the penalty kill.

- The Stars are also one of the least-penalized teams in the league, ranking 26th and 27th, respectively, in the league in both total penalty minutes (543; tied) and penalty minutes per game (6:57) entering play Wednesday.
- Entering play Wednesday, Esa Lindell was leading all NHL skaters in both total shorthanded ice time (283:09) and shorthanded ice time per game (3:38) this season.
 - Lindell had played 20 more minutes of shorthanded ice time than the second ranked player (Mike Matheson; 263:25) entering play Wednesday.
