## THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned at least one point in five of their last seven home contests against the Flyers (4-2-1) and they have recorded at least four goals in each of their wins in that span.

**JJ Peterka** has tallied 34 points (16+18) in his last 32 games and he has registered 11 points (4+7) in his last 10 games.



**Rasmus Dahlin** has posted 16 points (5+11) in his last 13 games, including nine points (3+6) in his last seven contests.

**Tagge Thompson** has posted 47 points (28+19) in his last 46 games, including 12 points (10+2) in his last 12 games.

**Thompson** leads all NHL skaters in even-strength goals (37) this season.

If **Thompson** finishes the season ranked first in even-strength goals, it will mark the first time a Sabres skater has done so in franchise history.

**Alex Tuch** has registered 14 points (8+6) in his last 11 games.

**Tuch** ranks first among NHL forwards in blocked shots (110) and second among forwards in takeaways (46) this season.

**Tuch** is one of 10 forwards who have registered 100 or more blocked shots in a single season since 2005-06. He currently ranks second all-time and is two blocked shots away from recording the most (Mathieu Dandenault; 2006-07; 111 blocked shots).

**Jack Quinn** has tallied 11 points (4+7) in his last 12 games.

**Lindy Ruff** is one win away from becoming just the fifth coach in NHL history to reach 900 regular-season wins in their career.

## ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 2-2-0 all-time on April 17 (regular season).

April 17, 1980: Gilbert Perreault picks up four assists in the Sabres' 6-4 win against the Chicago Blackhawks in game two of the Stanley Cup Quarterfinals.

April 17, 2013: Patrick Kaleta plays his 300th career NHL game in a 3-2 shootout win at Boston.

## PHILLY SPECIAL

**Alex Tuch** is riding a three-game point streak against the Flyers (1+3) and he has registered nine points (4+5) in his last six games against Philadelphia.

**Rasmus Dahlin** has registered three points (2+1) in his last two games against Philadelphia.

**Dahlin** would match the longest goal streak by a Sabres defenseman against the Flyers all-time (Brandon Montour; three games; March 9 to 31, 2021; 4+0) with a goal today.

**JJ Peterka** is riding a five-game assist streak against the Flyers and he would match the longest assist streak against Philadelphia by a Sabres skater all-time (Gilbert Perreault; Jan. 31, 1974 to Feb. 20, 1975; 1+6) with an assist in tonight's game.

**Ryan McLeod** has tallied at least one point in each of the two games he has played against the Flyers as a member of the Sabres and he has posted four total points in that span (1+3).

Only Dave Andreychuk from Feb. 23 to Dec. 11, 1983 (six points; 3+3) and Alan Haworth from Jan. 28 to March 8, 1981 (five points; 3+2) recorded more points in their first two games against the Flyers with Buffalo.

**Jack Quinn** has notched six points (4+2) in his last four games against Philadelphia, including two goals in his last home game against the Flyers on April 5, 2024.
