TOP NOTES

As a result of his goal, **Zach Benson** has now recorded four points (3+1) in his last four games. He has registered three points (2+1) in three career games against St. Louis.

Peyton Krebs' primary assist on **Benson's** goal gave him one point in back-to-back games (1+1).

Owen Power picked up the secondary assist on **Benson's** goal and he has now collected at least one assist in three consecutive games. The assist marked his sixth assist streak of three or more games in his career.

Alex Tuch recorded an assist on **Ryan McLeod's** goal and he notched the gametying goal in the third period. He has posted seven points (2+5) in his last six games. **Tuch** has recorded eight points (3+5) in his last seven games against the Blues.

Tuch's goal marked the sixth time he has scored to tie a game in the third period in his career. It was the third time he has done so with Buffalo, and the first time since March 13, 2023 at Toronto.

McLeod's assist on **Tuch's** game-tying goal gave him two points (1+1) in tonight's game. Tonight's game marked the 10th time in his career that he has notched at least one goal and one assist in a single game. He last did so with Edmonton on March 9, 2024 at Buffalo.

Rasmus Dahlin's overtime goal was the third of his career and his first since Feb. 29, 2024 in a 3-2 victory over the Tampa Bay Lightning. **Dahlin** has notched 12 points (4+8) in his last nine games.

Dahlin's goal extended his point streak to five games (3+4), which marked the first time he has notched a point streak of five or more games since Oct. 14 to 29, 2023 (eight games; 2+7). It marked the ninth point streak of five or more games in his career.

As a result of his goal, **Dahlin** has moved into a tie with Phil Housley and Tyler Myers for the second-most overtime goals by a defenseman (3) in franchise history.

JJ Peterka recorded the primary assist on **Dahlin's** goal. He has now registered at least one point in five consecutive games and he has tallied seven points in that span (3+4). With the assist, **Peterka** matched the longest point streak of his career (five games; Oct. 27 to Nov. 4, 2023; 3+3).
