BATTLE OF THE BULLDOGS

Tomorrow's game will feature a quartet of University of Minnesota-Duluth alumni, including Kings defenseman **Mikey Anderson** (2017-19) and Winnipeg skaters **Dylan Samberg** (2017-20), **Neal Pionk** (2015-2017) and former LA King **Alex Iafallo** (2013-2017). During his time at Minnesota-Duluth, Anderson's defensive partner was Samberg. Three of the four skaters sit in the top-five on the all-time games played list among active Minnesota-Duluth hockey alumnus in the NHL, joining St. Louis' **Justin Faulk** (925 GP) and Vancouver's **Carson Soucy** (309 GP).

KING OF KINGS

Captain **Anze Kopitar** returns to Crypto.com Arena with three multi-point performances in his last five outings, dating back to Nov. 13, 2024, in Colorado. With a goal and an assist on Monday in San Jose, Kopitar recorded the 308th multi-point game of his career and reached the quarter-century mark on the campaign for a 19th time. In doing so, Kopitar became the 32nd player in league history to record as many seasons with at least 25 points. With the 307th multi-point game (0-2=2) on Saturday afternoon versus Seattle, the veteran forward passed **Phil Housley** (338-894=1,232) for 43rd on the League's all-time scoring list.

JUICE IS LOOSE

Forward **Adrian Kempe** has tallied five goals and seven points (5-2=7) over his last five games dating back to Nov. 13, 2024. On Monday night at SAP Center, the winger recorded both his 10th and 11th assists of the campaign, marking his 77th-career multi-point game for the Kings which tied **Jari Kurri** for the 19th-most multi-point efforts in franchise history. Kempe scored his 10th goal of the campaign during Saturday's matinee against Seattle following a week that saw the winger notch multiple goals (Nov. 13 at COL: 2-0=2; Nov. 16 vs. DET: 2-0=2) in back-to-back contests for the fourth time in his career. Kempe's quartet of multigoal stretches account for four of the Kings' seven such streaks in the past decade. The only Kings skater to record a longer multi-goal streak in the 21st century was **Alex Frolov**, who posted a three-game run from Nov. 13, 2006 – Nov. 18, 2006 (6-2=8).
