MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has earned points in five of the six meetings over the last three campaigns (4-1-1).
- ★ The home team has won six of the past seven matchups and seven of the past nine games in the series.
- ★ CBJ have earned points in 11 of the last 14 games at Calgary (9-3-2) with six of those contests being decided past regulation (CBJ 4-2 in those games).
- The winning team has won by three goals in three-straight meetings and multiple goals in seven of the past eight.
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more goals in five of the past eight games in the series.
- ★ The Jackets have scored on 33.3 percent of their power play chances over the last five contests (4-of-12).



JACKET TO WATCH - D Zach Werenski

Has tallied 5-6-11 with four multi-point efforts in 14 career GP against the Flames. Has recorded six points over his last five outings (3-3-6).





FLAME TO WATCH - C Nazem Kadri

Slated to play in 1,000th career NHL game on Wednesday. Has tallied 12-12-24 with six multi-point efforts in 27 career GP vs. CBJ. Has totaled 5-7-12 in last 7 home GP vs. Jackets.



TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus had its four-game win streak snapped in a 3-2 loss at the NY Islanders on Sunday. The club is 6-2-0 in the past eight contests since Oct. 18.
- ★ CBJ also had their four-game road win streak snapped on Sunday. The contest kicked off a stretch of nine of 12 games played away from Nationwide Arena through Nov. 24, including a five-game road trip from Nov. 2-11.
- ★ The Jackets rank in the top-10 in the NHL in various road categories, including shots/game (2nd, 33.7), goals scored/game (3rd, 3.83), power play pct. (6th, 30.8) and points pct. (7th-T, .667).
- ★ Columbus has played in one-goal decisions in four of the past five contests (3-1-0 in those outings).
- ★ CBJ blueliners have recorded 11-15-26 in 12 games and lead the league in goals scored and percentage of team goals (28.2).
 The club tied a CBJ record with 51 goals (also 2017-18) and trailed only Colorado in goals from defensemen in 2024-25.
- ★ The Blue Jackets play their first five games against the Pacific Division this season (Calgary, Edmonton-2, Vancouver, Seattle) from Nov. 5-13. The team finished 7-7-2 against the division in 2024-25.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C Charlie Coyle has posted points in five of the past eight contests (2-6-8).
- ★ Goaltenders Jet Greaves (3-3-0, .916 SV%, .936 EV SV%) and Elvis Merzlikins (4-2-0, .917 SV%, .932 EV SV%) rank in the top-10 in the league in both save percentage (Merzlikins, 6th; Greaves, 7th-T) and even strength save percentage (Greaves, 5th; Merzlikins, 7th).
- * RW Kirill Marchenko has registered assists in a career-high five-straight contests (0-5-5) and has points in 10 of the 12 games in 2025-26 (5-7-12). He leads the team in goals (tied), assists (tied), points and shots on goals (tied, 42).
- C Sean Monahan has collected points in six of the last seven games (1-5-6) and became the fourth player from the 2013 NHL Draft to record 600 career points (264-337-601, 830 GP) with the game-winner on Nov. 1 vs. the Blues.
- ★ D Zach Werenski (4-6-10, 12 GP) tied his personal best and the club record for a defensemen with goals and multiple points in three-straight games from Oct. 28-Nov. 1 (3-3-6).
- ★ LW Miles Wood notched a goal on Sunday at the NY Islanders and has 3-0-3 in the past four appearances.
