### AT A GLANCE

#### BLACKHAWK DOWN(TOWN LA)

The Kings return to action at Crypto.com Arena for a two-game set against the Chicago Blackhawks on Thursday, Dec. 4, and Saturday, Dec. 6. The Kings are currently riding a nine-game home point streak (7-0-2) against Chicago, dating back to March 2, 2019. It is the second-longest active home point streak against any one opponent for the Kings and is the sixth-longest active home point streak among all League teams against the Blackhawks. Should the team collect a point versus Chicago on Thursday evening in DTLA, it would mark the team's second active home point streak of at least 10 games against any one opponent, joining a 10-game (7-0-3) streak against the St. Louis Blues, dating back to March 5, 2021.

#### OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN



Captain **Anze Kopitar** enters tomorrow's contest against **Connor Bedard** and the Blackhawks with 42 career points (16-26=42) against the Central Division foe in 57 career games played. He looks to break a tie with **Butch Goring** (15-27=42) for third most points against Chicago in franchise history behind **Dave Taylor** (20-23=43) and **Marcel Dionne** (21-37=58) tomorrow evening at Crypto.com Arena. With his assist on Tuesday against Washington, Kopitar (445-847=1,292) is now 15 points away from tying Dionne (550-757=1,307) for the most points in LA Kings team history and is eight away from reaching the 1,300-point milestone.



#### CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'

Defenseman **Joel Edmundson** scored his third goal of the season in the Kings' Black Friday matinee against the rival Anaheim Ducks. His performance in Orange County was preceded by factoring in on both (0-2=2) of the Kings' tallies during their win over Ottawa last Monday, Nov. 24, bringing his point total on the season to 11 (2-9=11). With his efforts last week, Edmundson is second in defensive scoring and tied with **Brandt Clarke** (9 A) for third-most assists amongst all Kings skaters behind only **Quinton Byfield** (15 A) and **Adrian Kempe** (14 A). The 6-5, 220-pound blueliner hosts the Chicago Blackhawks for just the second time since Oct. 26, 2019 (w/ STL) having earned five points (2-3=5) in six visits to the Windy City over that span.
