TOP NOTES

Kyle Okposo's goal marked his 600th point in his NHL career. He has registered four goals in his last nine games, which marks the first time he has recorded four or more goals in a nine-game span since he scored four goals from Dec. 29, 2022 vs. Detroit to Jan. 14, 2023 at Nashville.

Okposo has now recorded 231 points as a member of the Sabres, the 44thmost on Buffalo's all-time points list. His goal was his 95th with Buffalo, the 38th-most in Sabres history.

Devon Levi made 29 saves in tonight's game and became the youngest Sabres goaltender since Tom Barrasso from Feb. 8, 1987 to Feb, 20, 1987 (four games) to record 29 or more saves in two or more consecutive games. Barrasso (10 times) is the only other goaltender Levi's age or younger who had done so entering tonight's game.

Okposo's goal marked the second time he had scored to tie a game in the third period this season. He also did so in a 3-2 victory on Nov. 24 vs. Pittsburgh.

Since being acquired by Buffalo, Jeff Skinner has recorded 25 points (14+11) in 15 games against Montreal. With his goal, he now leads all Sabres skaters in goals (12) in 2023-24.

Tage Thompson tallied an assist on Skinner's goal and he has now tallied a point in each of the three games (1+2) he has played in since returning from injury. He recorded 11 points (5+6) in 10 games played before his injury.

With his assist, Thompson has now registered 10 points (5+5) in 10 career games against Montreal.

With his assist on Okposo's game-tying goal, Connor Clifton has recorded an assist in consecutive games. It marked the third time in his career that he had notched at least one assist in consecutive games, and the first time he has done so as a member of the Sabres.

Owen Power's shootout goal was the second of his career. He is now 2-for-2 on shootout attempts in his career.

With his shootout goal in tonight's game, Victor Olofsson now has three shootout goals in his career. He is one of seven Sabres skaters who have scored three or more shootout goals on 10 or fewer shootout attempts with Buffalo.
