PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars have the day off on Sunday, April 14 and Monday, April 15. They'll return to practice on Tuesday, April 16 at 11 a.m. CT at Comerica Center.

NOTES

- The Stars (51-21-9; 111 points) clinched first place in their division for the 11th time in franchise history and first since 2015-16, when they concluded the season atop the Central Division and Western Conference.

- With a goal and an assist, forward **Jason Robertson** (29-51—80 in 81 GP) became the third Stars player to record consecutive 80-point seasons, a feat achieved by only **Jamie Benn** (2 from 2014-15 to 2015-16) and **Mike Modano** (multiple times) since the club began play in Texas.

- Today marked defenseman **Miro Heiskanen's** fifth game of the season with three or more points after scoring a goal and tallying two assists (1-2—3). Heiskanen leads Stars blueliners in assists (45) and points (9-45—54) in 70 GP this season.

- Forward **Craig Smith** (1-0—1) tallied his 11th goal of the season with just two seconds left in the first period. The veteran has 20 points (11-9—20) in 74 GP this season, has reached double digits in goals in 11 of his 13 NHL campaigns.

- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** picked up his 33rd assist of the season to give him 48 points (15-32—47) in 78 GP. Harley continues to lead Dallas blueliners in goals (15) and ranks second in assists (32) and points.

- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** made 26 saves on 27 shots to improve his record this season to 34-14-4. He also improved to 6-1-1 in eight career appearances vs. Seattle.
