Oct. 24 vs. Washington

- Dallas has won nine of the last 13 meetings (CBJ; 4-8-1) after Columbus won 16-of-21 (16-4-1) from Dec. 29, 2011-Mar. 4, 2021.
- The Stars have won six of the last seven home meetings in the series between the clubs (CBJ; 4-1 win on Feb. 18, 2023).
- The winning team has scored four-plus goals in five consecutive and 12 of the past 16 dating back to Feb. 2, 2021.
- The winning team has also won by multiple goals in each of the past five meetings as well as eight of the last 10.
- CBJ have allowed a single power play goal in the last 12 meetings since Mar. 13, 2021 (20-of-21, 95.2 pct.).
- Columbus has recorded two shutouts in the all-time series (MR: Bobrovsky, 32 saves in 3-0 W at Dallas on Oct. 22, 2016) as well as both penalty shot attempts (MR: Bemstrom, Mar. 13, 2021).

JACKET TO WATCH - D DAMON SEVERSON

Has posted 2-7-9 in 19 career GP against the Stars. Collected an assist in most recent meeting and has 1-5-6 in the last nine contests against the club. Also has 1-2-3 in last 4 outings at Dallas.





STAR TO WATCH - LW JASON ROBERTSON

Has 6-7-13 with 4 multi-point efforts in 14 career GP against the Blue Jackets. Has notched points in each of his last four contests (2-4-6) as well as eight of the past nine (5-7-12).



TEAM NOTES

- The Blue Jackets wrapped up a three-game homestand with a 3-2 victory over Tampa Bay on Saturday.
- Tuesday's contest at Dallas begins a stretch of three-of-four played away from Nationwide Arena through Oct. 28.
- Columbus has outscored opponents 11-5 during 5-on-5 play with the five goals against the fewest allowed by any team in the NHL in 2025-26.
- CBJ rank fifth in the league in shots on goal per game (31.6) and faceoff winning percentage (54.8 pct.).
- The Jackets have gone 2-2-0 in the first four of six-straight games against opponents that qualified for the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs.
- CBJ have scored the first goal in three of the past four contests (2-1-0 when scoring first).

PLAYER NOTES

- RW Kirill Marchenko, who has points in four-straight games (5-1-6) after being held off the scoresheet in the season opener, is the first player in CBJ history with five goals in the first five contests of a season.
- C Charlie Coyle sits two assists shy of 300 for his NHL career (189-298-487, 955 GP).
- G Jet Greaves (77-of-83, .928 SV%) and G Elvis Merzlikins (80-of-87, .920 SV%) have combined to turn aside 157-of-170 shots faced through the first five contests this season (.924 SV%). They are one of just two goaltender tandems in wich each netminder has a .920 SV% or better (WSH - Lindgren, .932; Thompson, .922).
- LW Dmitri Voronkov has notched points in four of the five contests in 2025-26 (2-3-5). He notched career highs with 23-24-47 in 73 outings last season.
- D Zach Werenski has registered 1-3-4 in the first five contests and leads NHL blueliners in shots on goal (22), while ranking second in TOI/GP (26:39) and third-T in plus/minus rating (+6).
